





## A full year in a state of emergency

The Province has formally extended the provincial state of emergency, allowing health and emergency management officials to continue to use extraordinary powers under the Emergency Program Act (EPA) to support the Province's COVID-19 pandemic response.

It is extended through the end of the day on March 16, 2021, which will mark a year since the state of emergency was first declared on March 18, 2020.

## Pile burning to continue all week

You may have seen the smoke in the area of Tom Lacey Trails (above Mountain Drive near Allen Rd), this is part of a 100% grant-funded prescribed fuel management project; which includes some burning to reduce our wildfire risk by slowing fire spread.


The project is 100% funded by a provincial Community Resiliency Investment Grant of more than \$162,000.

The contractor, HIS Ventures, will work in the posted block falling trees, running equipment, and burning piles over the next few months; all in keeping with the current look and feel of previously treated areas above Mountain Dr.

By removing stands of trees (creating space between trees) and clearing the surface vegetation (twigs, needles, and dead leaves) the speed and intensity at which fire moves through the area is reduced. The project also focuses on removing ladder fuels (fuels that bring fire from the ground up to the crown of a tree), by burning the vegetation and/or removing/chipping the fuels and bringing them elsewhere.

The Bench neighbourhood has been highlighted as an area of concern in Merritt's Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP), and this project is part of the City's ongoing commitment to prepare the community for the realities of living within the wildland-urban interface. This work allows for fire suppression methods to be set up and community members time to evacuate in the event of a fire. This work does not negate the work required by homeowners and renters to mitigate their own personal risk on their own property. FMI firerescue.merritt.ca/wildfire-safety/
