



DLCC vs NVFG

After their defeat on Friday, when the BC Supreme Court decided for Douglas Lake Cattle Co. — regarding the 20-year long fight for public access to Mini & Stoney Lakes — the Nicola Valley Fish & Game Club said that they will arrange financing, and file an appeal with the Supreme Court of Canada.

Vaccine roll-out starts

Starting today, seniors aged 90+, Aboriginal people aged 65+ and Elders are able to call Interior Health to book their vaccination appointment. Immunization appointments will begin in our region on Monday, March 15.

Health authorities are registering individuals starting in the 3 age groupings: Call on or after Mon., March 8 if you were born in or before 1931 (90+ years), or you are an Aboriginal person born in or before 1956 (65+ years), and Elders. Call on or after Mon. March 15 if you were born in or before 1936 (85+ years). Call on or after Mon., March 22 if you were born in 1941 or earlier (80+ years)

Only call in when you're eligible. You may call in any time after you become eligible. Family members or those who provide trusted support can call in to register eligible seniors for a vaccine appointment.

To register, call 1-877-740-7747 between 7am - 7pm, seven days a week. In Merritt, the vaccinations will take place at Merritt Public Health, 3451 Voght St., starting March 15, and will operate 3 days per week.

IHA wants to remind everyone to be vigilant against fraud. Call centres will never ask for financial information, credit card details, or social insurance numbers. The call centre will only ask for your legal name, date of birth, postal code, personal health number, and current contact info.



Ice fishing photo contest


