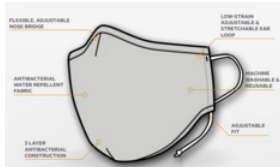

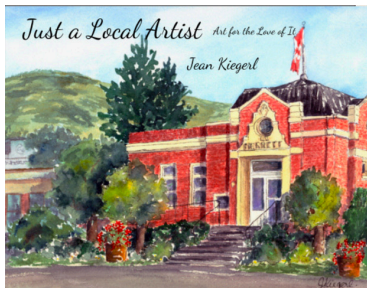

Above average snowpack for Nicola

The River Forecast Centre released its March 1 Snow Survey & Water Supply bulletin this week. They say that across the province, snowpacks are above average, after a colder-than-normal February. In the Nicola basin, it is 119%.

By early March, approx. 80% of the annual snowpack will have accumulated. La Niña conditions & seasonal forecasts from Environment and Climate Change Canada between now & May indicate the likelihood of cooler conditions and possibly greater than normal precipitation. This could lead to continued snow accumulation, delayed snow melt — an increased risk for freshet related flooding.

Citizen trust & responsibility challenged

The recent excellent letter by Doug Fleming; and the disgusting revelations about the apparent excessive spending by Gill (a former Finance Director of Merritt!), (and his 'retirement stipend of our \$500,000) have made it clear to me that we owe it to ourselves to not take our democratic rights for granted. We have a privilege that few in this world have; to elect our representatives. But with that privilege, we have assumed that we can trust those representatives; and my trust has been shaken lately.

That basic tenet of trust needs re-assurance: in the TNRD and in Merritt. Citizens need to know that they WILL be earnestly listened to; and that elected officials will ensure us that they can be trusted. I hate to suggest more government; but it appears that the Act, and City policy needs fixing. As a bare minimum, our Council members should file public disclosure of their 'official' expenses, annually; and City staff should also disclose. I commend TNRD's Chairman Gillis for implementing a 'whistleblower' policy, but we have seen how secrecy has been mocked by such policies in other areas. Lets hope he is successful. Remember; Mayor Brown is our elected rep on the TNRD.

Merritt's OCP is under review now. Recently, it has become very apparent that the current OCP provides lame excuses for many actions of our civic government. The City hired a Kelowna firm as consultant; and it has become apparent to me that what we're getting from the consultant is designed to have our Merritt look like Kelowna; sprawl and high rises, and congestion! The time has come to be proactive; examine the issues concerning the OCP, now, and 'trust' that your comments will be listened to. If you don't accept that responsibility, don't cry when Council in future places high rises in your backyard.

Summer Program Assistant Merritt Library

The Thompson-Nicola Regional Library (TNRL) is seeking a temporary part time Summer Program Assistant (Arts and Leisure Leader) for the Merritt Library. The Assistant will be responsible for planning, promoting, developing, and delivering summer programming to one or more of the following groups: preschool children, school-age children, teens, adults, or seniors.

Duties include preparing and organizing materials used in summer programs, inspiring patrons to join summer programs through social media and other types of media outreach, and planning and developing programming for summer programs. The Assistant will also work to support the delivery of the programming they've planned, whether the programs are passive, take-home, virtual, or in person.

The Assistant will build connections with community groups such as schools, daycares, preschools, day camps, and seniors' groups. The position may require travel with-in Merritt or to communities outside of Merritt.
