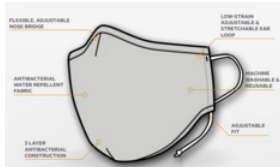

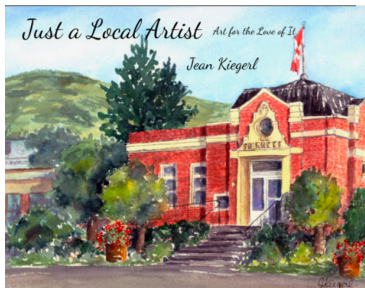

Bank above Nicola slipping into the river

On February 4th about 9pm, residents of Spring Bank Ave. heard a loud noise, and discovered that a substantial amount of the bank (on private land, not visible from the road) had slid into the Nicola River, bringing the river at that location to roughly half the width it had been.

It was just prior to the last cold snap. There had been some rain & snow melt — enough to erode the clay cliff, taking with it part of a chainlink fence & some piping.

According to the City, “the slippage was far enough away that there was no immediate concern [about public infrastructure].” And it is deemed ‘naturally occurring land slippage.’ According to a Min. of Forests hydrologist, “we can expect that the river will continue to move slowly over time”, though there’s no way to predict how.

Neighbours are worried that increased lawn-watering could contribute over the long term to the bank’s erosion, as well as increased traffic once the Spring Bank-Grimmett connector is built. Of more pressing concern is the upcoming freshet, especially after this year’s above-average snowpack.

And they think it also brings into question the safety of more development in the area, including the Nicola Lodge apartment project that goes to public hearing this coming Tuesday.

Meanwhile, residents are warily monitoring the site of new slide. They expect it will have to be added to the City’s map of geotechnical hazards, which should make it more difficult to build in the area.

Hwy 5A would not be safer without trucks

Min. of Transportation managers made a presentation to TNRD Board last week, and answered pointed questions about Hwy 5A and the issue of commercial trucks.

The latest petition to ban commercial trucks from the road was delivered to TNRD Directors in December, from residents & ranchers.

The presenters said that the road was absolutely built for commercial trucks, as it was the primary route between Merritt and Kamloops before the Coquihalla opened. And they cite major upgrades in the past 10 years which now makes 5A “the lowest violation ticket per enforcement hour in the district”.

CERIP funding for NV groups

Two local organizations have received funding from the provincial gov’t Community Economic Recovery Infrastructure Program (CERIP) for the Destination Development Stream. The Nicola Valley Fall Fair Association will put theirs towards Fall Fair building improvements. Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC will launch a fishing access improvement project in Merritt and Nicola Valley.

Under the CERIP the Province is committing up to \$90 million to support community economic resilience, tourism, heritage, urban & rural economic development projects.
