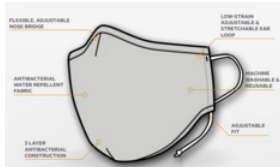

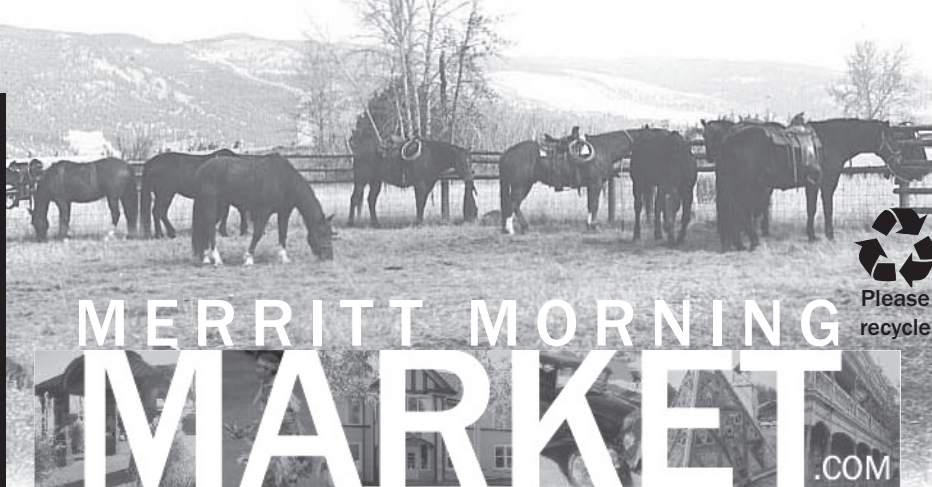

## Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh

10 June, 1921 - 9 April, 2021

With the news of Prince Philip's passing on Friday, stories are being shared all around the world. And there are stories from the Nicola Valley, too.

In 1959 Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip paid a visit to Penask Lake, at Chunky Woodward's invitation, for a 2-day break during their Western Canada tour. They then resumed their trip by train (presumably from Kamloops), with a stop in Spences Bridge, where they were met by a delegation of Merritt Brownies, Cubs, Scouts, Guides and Legion members, along with Chairman Allan Collett & his wife. "In chatting with Chairman Collett both the Queen and Prince Philip expressed surprise at the nearness of Merritt to Penask Lake, where they has spent the weekend, and showed keen interest in Merritt and in the groups at Spences Bridge." *Merritt Herald*, July 16, 1959.

The prince returned to Douglas Lake Ranch in 1962, a stop on his way to open the Seattle's World Fair. It was then he saw his first cutting horse demonstration. In 1964, the Canadian Cutting Horse Association (with Chunky Woodward heavily involved) was invited to the Royal Windsor Horse Show and a 3-month tour of Great Britain, during which time a Douglas Lake Quarter horse was gifted to the prince, and later given to Prince Charles as a polo mount.

A private recreation site, remains to this day, Prince Phillips Point on Douglas Lake, designated to commemorate the 1962 visit.

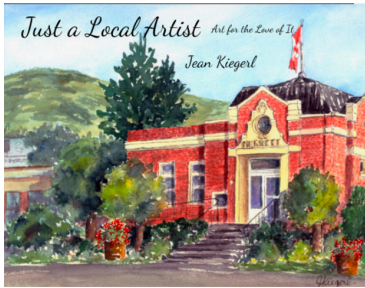
