Shooting for 'The Good Doctor' wrapping up

Filming has been going on since Monday in town, for the ABC television medical drama *The Good Doctor*, set at a fictional San Jose, CA hospital.

Seniors' apartment project now underway

Construction is now underway on a new affordable 44-unit seniors apartment building — the project was first announced in 2019, funded by the BC Govt.

The new Cedar Terrace apartment will be located at 2230 Quilchena Ave., next to Juniper House, and will provide studio, 1-bedroom and accessible apartments in a 4-storey building.

ASK Wellness Society will operate the new homes for seniors with moderate and low incomes. The society is receiving approximately \$4.7 million from the Province's Building BC: Community Housing Fund.

Construction is expected to be complete in summer 2022.

Platonopolis

The rulers of the day dismissed the idea. They did so because an environment able to empower a common person isn't in their benefit and an enlightened populous isn't so easy to exploit.

For the same reason, throughout history, great storehouses of knowledge akin to the Library of Alexandria, the magnificent Library of Nalanda, the Mayan libraries of the Yucatan, the Library of al-Hakam II, the Xianyang Palace Library, and the Sikh Reference Library were destroyed.

The exploitation of the masses is what empowers the ruling classes and if the people realize their standing, the ruling elite will eventually lose their status. But so long as the people can not conceptualize their disposition, they can not challenge the exploitation. — Mike Bhangu

Test of provincial emergency alert

At 1:55pm today, May 5, a test of BC's wireless alerting system will be conducted as part of the national Alert Ready system to improve public safety in the event of emergency.

This is part of a biannual test of the national Alert Ready system, which was launched in BC on April 6, 2018. This testing is to assess the system's readiness for an actual emergency and identify any adjustments that need to be made. A scheduled test in May 2020 was cancelled across Canada due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the test, an alert will be broadcast on radio and television stations, as well as on compatible wireless devices: "This is a TEST of the British Columbia Emergency Alerting System, issued by Emergency Management British Columbia. This is ONLY a TEST. If this had been an actual emergency or threat, you would now hear instructions that would assist you to protect you and your family. For further information go to www.emergencyinfbc.gov.bc.ca. This is ONLY a TEST, no action is required."


