Notice of gate change

The operator of the Nicola Lake dam has informed the City that a gate change was being made on Wednesday to increase Nicola River flows from ~13m³/s to approximately 20m³/s.

The Nicola river as it flows through Merritt is fed by the combination of the outflow of Nicola Lake (governed by the dam), and the outflow from Clapperton/Mill Creek (uncontrolled, and responsive entirely to the weather). Clapperton Creek is flowing at ~4.25m³/s, so the combined flow through Merritt will be ~24.25m³/s. The change has caused river levels to rise by about 7 inches.

The City says there is still plenty of storage capacity in Nicola Lake and this increase in flows is being made to ensure the lake doesn't fill too quickly, and to preserve capacity in the event of heavy precipitation in the next few weeks.

There is no risk of flooding with this change, though they anticipate that groundwater levels will rise — so residents in the lowest lying areas may need to turn on sump pumps.

Staff at the City and the Ministry continue to keep water levels under constant observation. Subject to any potential changes in weather, no further gate changes are expected this week.

Fed. investigation into TNRD spending

The Federal Serious and Organized Crime (FSOC) Financial Integrity Unit will take over the investigation into potential criminality at the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, with Kamloops RCMP assisting as needed.

TNRD is doing its own third-party review into the regional district's financial records and expenses., led by BDO Canada. The audit comes after a report from *Kamloops This Week* showed more than \$517,000 of taxpayers money was expended by former CAO, Sukh Gill between 2015 & 2020, much of that spending was on luxury hotels, fine restaurants, coffee shops, golf courses and other high-end discretionary locations, for himself and other TNRD directors and staff. All findings of the forensic audit & financial review will be made public.

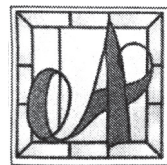
