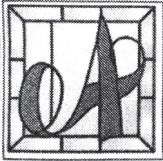

Chyzowski named new Cents coach

The Merritt Centennials have announced Dave Chyzowski as the team's new Head Coach and General Manager, on a 2-year deal with a 3rd year option.

Categories 2 & 3 open fire prohibition

Effective at noon on Friday, June 11, Cat. 2 & 3 open fires, as well as other equipment and activities will be prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre — to help prevent human-caused wildfires and protect public safety. The prohibition will remain in effect until noon on Oct. 15, or until the order is rescinded. Anyone conducting Cat. 2 or Cat. 3 open fires must extinguish those fires by the June 11th deadline.

Prohibited activities include: Category 2 & Category 3 open fires; fireworks; sky lanterns and, burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description, except when used for a campfire as defined by the Wildfire Regulation.

These prohibitions apply to all public and private land within the Kamloops Fire Centre jurisdiction. Anyone found in contravention may be issued a ticket for \$1150, required to pay an administrative penalty of up to \$10,000 or, if convicted in court, fined up to \$100,000 and/or sentenced to one year in jail. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person responsible may be ordered to pay all fire-fighting and associated costs.

This prohibition does not ban campfires that are a half-metre high by a high-metre wide or smaller and does not apply to cooking stoves that use gas, propane, or briquettes.
