# to Quebec, Ontario On Friday, the BC Wildfire Service

sent 120 firefighters and 3 support staff to Quebec to help with firefighting efforts there. Saturday, another 60 firefighters and 1 support staff were deployed, for a total of 184 personnel in Quebec.

Yesterday, another 20 firefighters and 1 support staff were sent to Ontario.

CÔVID-19 precautions will be taken to protect the health of everyone participating, both during their time in Central Canada and on their return to this province. Firefighters will remain within their own 'bubbles' and conduct operations separately from Quebec & Ontario firefighters.

Crews can be recalled at any time if wildfire conditions change in BC. Given the current fire situation, we have sufficient resources in place to respond appropriately to wildfire activity here.

These are the babies of the residential schools who grew up. The children, grandchildren and great grandchildren of the babies who physically survived the schools, but sometimes only physically survived.

We grieve today for the babies, but we must remember that some of these babies grew up — and we must grieve for the futures they lost as well. Let our grief for the children be a reminder that the adults were once children who needed us then — and while we can't go back, we can move forward with greater understanding of the paths they walk.


