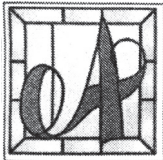

Lytton evacuees find help in Merritt

Initially Wednesday evening, the City of Merritt set up a reception centre at their Emergency Social Services building at 1721 Coldwater Ave. for Lytton evacuees — to register, and get accommodation for people and animals alike.

The next day, they moved it to the Civic Centre where group lodging was available, along with incidental resources. They encouraged everyone evacuating from Lytton to register, even if they do not want to access assistance.

By Saturday, the reception centres in Merritt and Kamloops were full, and evacuees were being directed to reception centres in the Chilliwack Secondary School, and Salvation Army, in Kelowna.

Shulus Arena opened to evacuees & donation collection. The Lower Nicola Indian Band's plan was to accommodate overflow in the Band School & Rocky Pines Community Centre, if needed.

Lytton Crk fire update

The Lytton Creek wildfire, started Wednesday evening & engulfed the town of Lytton within 20 minutes, is now estimated at 7600 hectares. It is still classified as 'out of control', though there has been minimal growth outside the perimeter.

Late Friday, a 4-hectare excursion happened on the west side of the Fraser north of the Stein River, and resources were diverted immediately, and continues to be a priority. It is "exhibiting minimal fire behaviour. 43 firefighters, 8 helicopters & 4 heavy equipment are on scene.

"So the other day the Town of Lytton BC burnt down. Some of hottest weather recorded anywhere in North America for the day.

The suspected cause of the fire was the train rolling through town.

There are 2 tracks on either side of the Fraser River. Fire jumped the river. Which is no small feat if you know the area. And all the rail bridges on both sides of the canyon also burnt down.

Essentially there is no rail traffic running to Vancouver, BC right now."

The Lytton Crk wildfire is now part of the Lytton Crk Complex including the George Rd wildfire. BC Wildfire reports there are now evacuation alerts for Nicomen, Cooks Ferry & Shackan.

After five days of hundreds of wildfires burning across the province, the BC Wildfire Service says it hopes the arrival of out-of-province support will help in battling the more than 180 active fires. Over 100 out-of-province fire crews are coming to assist and will arrive in the province today. As well, the Canadian Armed Forces will provide air support for areas affected by the wildfires until July 19.

Small fires in the area, all under control

A fire broke out Thursday evening on the south shore of Nicola Lake near Quilchena Hotel. Crews worked through the night to put it out, though it grew to 8.5 hectares.

Two lightning strikes started small fires near Stump Lake on Friday, and Meadow Creek near Logan Lake. By Sunday evening they were under control control, all under .5 hectares.

A lightning strike 10 mile W of Penask Lake started a fire, which has grown to 1.5 hectares. It is now under control.

Covid outbreak @ RIH

On Wednesdaym Interior Health declared a COVID-19 outbreak on unit 6 South at Royal Inland Hospital. To date, they've reported 7 patients and 0 staff members testing positive.

Although 6 South is a surgical unit, RIH surgeries are continuing at this time. Patients admitted after surgery will receive care on a different floor & 6 South is closed to admissions until further notice.

The hospital is safe to attend for appointments or emergency care. Please continue with any scheduled procedures and COVID-19 self-isolation is not required after visiting the hospital.
