Re: Water, water everywhere Wed. July 28

Letter 1: If Craig Gray would take a brief break from stalking cat feeders, he might want to open his eyes for a few seconds and look at the Nicola River as it runs through town. If he did so, he'd see it's running low - because we are indeed in a drought.

Publicly available data from the Government of Canada's Water Office shows that despite the incredibly low flows out through the Nicola River (less than 10% of what they were a few months ago), Nicola Lake's surface level has gone down by 9cm just in the last week. Yet again - this is because we are in a drought.

Mr Gray might not care about our most precious resource in this valley — water — but if he had a shred of dignity, he'd stop boasting so loudly about his cavalier attitude. —*Dan Smith*

Letter 2: Having watched Mr. Gray's latest of many tantrums at Council on Tuesday night, I read with interest his letter on Wednesday (July 28). Although he cited an important study, it's a true shame that he clearly hasn't read it.

According to the 2018 Golder study, the Nicola and Coldwater rivers are both "losing reaches" through Merritt - meaning their water is falling out from beneath them to recharge our aquifers. If we suck harder on the aquifers, more water leaves the rivers to recharge them. He then pretends that were "granny gray" to water her lawn, it would return to the aquifer — according to the study he cites, only 5% of the water that falls on the ground recharges the aquifers, "within the reported range for semi-arid regions of the United States and Saudi Arabia."

Mr. Gray must not have lived here very long if he thinks profligate water use in our dry climate is sustainable. Or perhaps he's the one who needs serious mental help, if he thinks Saudi Arabia are known for their green lawns and free use of water. Yours, *Charles Grove*

Letter 3: Drought is managed through the provincial government drought response plan (<https://bit.ly/37bskZf>). At drought levels 1 through 5 different levels of watering restrictions are recommended. Watering restrictions make sure we have water now and in the future. If there are thousands of Granny Gray's watering their lawns willy nilly then it's possible even with a 3 day lag in filtering the aquifers will not be maintained. If the drought is sustained, like this year, water shortages for personal and commercial use could be problem without those restrictions.

Sean Smith's (CAO City of Merritt) full comments on water in Merritt can be found at <https://bit.ly/3iloaVj> where he clearly states that the water situation in Merritt is tied closely to the Coldwater River. We can expand in Merritt if we continue to follow the provincial recommendations on watering restrictions during drought conditions.

The analogy most appropriate to our situation is to stand in the Coldwater River, and watch as it depth reduces from waist deep in some places in early June to ankle deep in those places in September even with watering restrictions. If the water in the Coldwater is not being replenished then neither are our aquifers.

It's important to note most of the Coldwater River flow diverted for human use is for agricultural purposes. Those agricultural purposes outrank other water uses except for normal domestic water use for Merritt. That is, in order to supply the water for the production of food crops for people and animals it may be necessary to restrict the use of water for non-essential uses as drought conditions worsen. —*Peter Vogt*

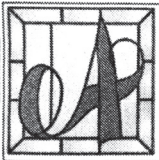
