More COVID restrictions kick in today

On Friday, Interior Health re-introduced public health orders covering the entire Interior Health region to manage COVID-19 activity: Masks mandatory in all indoor public spaces for people 12 years and older. Low-intensity indoor group exercise permitted to a max. 10 people per class. High-intensity indoor group exercise not permitted. Outdoor group exercise permitted up to 50 people per class.

Effective today at 8am: Gatherings in vacation rentals limited to 5 guests or 1 additional household. Indoor personal gatherings limited to 10 guests or 1 other household. Outdoor personal gatherings (e.g. birthday parties, backyard BBQs, block parties) limited to max. 50 people. Organized indoor gatherings (e.g. weddings, funerals, seated events) limited to 50 people, and outdoors gatherings limited to 100 people, both requiring a COVID-19 safety plan.

These measures will remain in place until the end of September and Interior Health experiences lower cases and higher vaccination rates.

Merritt evac alert rescinded Saturday

In consultation with and on the recommendation of the BC Wildfire Service, the City of Merritt rescinded its Evacuation Alert. Following favourable weather conditions and the work of the BC Wildfire Service, the July Mountain & Lytton Creek fires no longer pose an imminent risk to the safety of Merritt residents.

The City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) will continue to monitor the situation and should conditions change, an Evacuation Alert/Order could be reinstated or issued as the EOC deems necessary.

Although the Evacuation Alert has been rescinded, these are still considered wildfires of note and both fires are classified by the BC Wildfire Service as "Out of Control". They encourage you to remain informed and cautious of wildfire activity surrounding the community.

The Merritt Baptist Church will be cancelling services on Sunday, until the fire danger has passed. The congregation will be notified when services resume.
