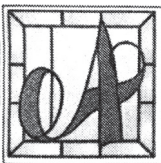

Drug alert for Merritt

On Thursday, Interior Health issued a drug alert for Kamloops/Merritt for a teal coloured powder known as 'Down'. It contains fentanyl, possible synthetic cannabinoid and can bring on possible overdose, hallucinations, disorientation, cold sweats, fear, panic.

They advise to provide calm approach, decrease stimulation, if necessary call 911 and give naloxone. The alert is in effect until September 30.

They also warn: No matter what or how you use (smoking, snorting, injecting) take steps to prevent overdose: Get your drugs checked - find locations at drugchecking.ca, avoid mixing, use with others around or at an overdose prevention site, start with a small amount, carry naloxone and know how use it, get the LifeGuard App - lifeguardh.com, Call 211 or visit bc211.ca to find nearby services.

Pipeline to be drilled under Nicola River

Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) will be used to cross under the Nicola River. This work takes place in a phased approach beginning with the establishment of temporary work spaces on either side of the area being crossed. One site will house a drilling rig and associated equipment, and the other will serve as a staging site for the pipe and will include welding and pipe stringing. After the site is prepared the crossing will be drilled, and then pipe pulled back through. After the drilling phase is complete the site will be cleared and returned to its original use.

For the majority of the pipeline route, conventional construction will be used - open-cut construction, which involves the pipe being set down into a trench and buried. Trenchless construction allows the pipe to safely cross underneath watercourse crossings, railways, highways, major roads, sensitive environmental areas, and in places with restricted work-space, such as in some urban areas. Several different trenchless methods can be employed, depending on geotechnical conditions, topography, available working space and length of the crossing.

Trans Mountain has approximately 40 major trenchless crossings planned for the Expansion Project, with the majority being horizontal directional drilling (HDD). These major crossings range between 400 metres and 1,600 metres in length and are located throughout the route of the pipeline.

Coho salmon enumeration activities
Coldwater River at Voght Park
— Until late November —

This project occurs annually in partnership with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and provides important information on Interior Fraser Coho. Coho are counted as they pass through a trap box and with the use of sonar. Migrating Coho that enter the trap box are sampled before being released upstream to continue their migration. Data collected includes length, sex, and origin (hatchery versus natural). Handling the fish also provides an opportunity to assess their overall health. The study design and operational procedures ensure minimal disruption to Coho migration and aim to reduce stress as much as possible. The majority of Coho migrate past the site unimpeded, through an opening in the fence, and are captured by the sonar unit. The injury rate of fish in the trap is very low; less than 0.2% of fish, on average, passing through the site display fresh wounds. This project is NWSFA's top priority during Coho migration and obtaining quality data to inform fisheries management decisions is the main objective.
