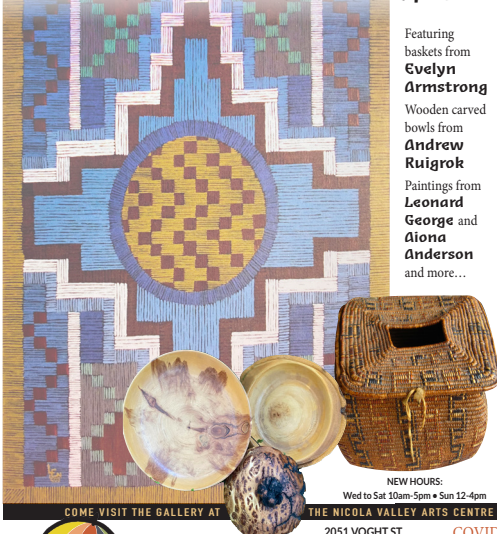

## Cannabis at 3 years

The value of BC's legal cannabis sector has more than quadrupled over the 3 years since Canada legalized non-medical cannabis.

The Province now has the 3rd-highest number of legal cannabis retail stores and 2nd-highest number of federal production licence holders in the country.

BC has 375 licensed private retail stores, plus 30 public retail stores under the BC Cannabis Stores brand. A further 57 applications from throughout the province for private stores are approved in principle, as government strives to assess, improve and tighten processing timelines for retail licensees.

To help encourage more B.C. cannabis consumers to shift to the legal market from the illicit, government is launching Buy Legal, a public education ad campaign encouraging people to buy cannabis from provincially authorized cannabis retail stores that offer regulated and tested products. This campaign also emphasizes helping to strengthen local economies and keep profits out of the hands of illegal operators and organized crime. The Province remains committed to reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples as they move toward self-determination and creating opportunities for Indigenous Peoples to be full partners in the economy, including the cannabis sector. BC is also developing an Indigenous shelf-space program to showcase Indigenous cannabis products.

The Province continues to work with the First Nations Leadership Council as federal and provincial cannabis policies evolve, as well as government-to-government with Nations in exploring cannabis-related agreements, such as the one reached with Williams Lake First Nation — now working to open up their first retail outlet outside their territory, Unity Cannabis in the Adelphi Hotel.

The agreement will allow WLFN to open up to 8 Unity Cannabis stores throughout the province.

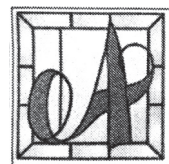

**Coho salmon enumeration activities**  
**Coldwater River at Voght Park**  
— Until late November —

This project occurs annually in partnership with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and provides important information on Interior Fraser Coho. Coho are counted as they pass through a trap box and with the use of sonar. Migrating Coho that enter the trap box are sampled before being released upstream to continue their migration. Data collected includes length, sex, and origin (hatchery versus natural). Handling the fish also provides an opportunity to assess their overall health. The study design and operational procedures ensure minimal disruption to Coho migration and aim to reduce stress as much as possible. The majority of Coho migrate past the site unimpeded, through an opening in the fence, and are captured by the sonar unit. The injury rate of fish in the trap is very low; less than 0.2% of fish, on average, passing through the site display fresh wounds. This project is NWSFA's top priority during Coho migration and obtaining quality data to inform fisheries management decisions is the main objective.
