## Flu shots encouraged

People in BC are being encouraged to protect themselves and those around them against influenza this year by getting a flu shot.

This year, influenza vaccination is free for everyone in BC 6 months and older.

Seasonal influenza and other respiratory viruses will be in communities alongside COVID-19 this fall and winter. In addition to COVID-19, it has the potential to escalate pressures already faced by the health-care system, particularly if the effects from COVID-19 and seasonal influenza occur at the same time.

In Merritt, influenza vaccines are available Black's Pharmacy until Dec 15, 2021. You must book an appointment.

The 2020/2021 vaccination is for: A/Victoria/2570/2019 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus; A/Cambodia/e0826360/2020 (H3N2)-like virus; B/Washington/02/2019-like virus; and B/Phuket/3073/2013-like virus. (The A/Victoria and A/Cambodia strains were not contained in the 2020/21 vaccines.)

## 'Drought conditions persist', Ag Canada

According to Agriculture Canada's evaluation of the Pacific region, "Despite ample precipitation in much of the region over the past 30 days, precipitation deficits from earlier in the growing season have resulted in persistent drought conditions.

It continues: "The central Interior continued to receive below-normal precipitation particularly in areas around Kelowna, Kamloops, Penticton, Vernon, and Cranbrook. These areas received between 60 and 75% of normal September rainfall."

The Nicola Valley falls in the edge of their Severe drought (D2) & Extreme drought (D3) zones.

According to provincial drought levels, the Coldwater improved this month to Level 1 (adverse impacts rare), the Nicola River dropped to to Level 2 (adverse impacts unlikely), while the Upper Nicola remains at Drought Level 4 (adverse impacts likely). All our area was at Level 4 drought from mid-July until the end of September.



## Coho salmon enumeration activities Coldwater River at Voght Park

— Until late November —

This project occurs annually in partnership with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and provides important information on Interior Fraser Coho. Coho are counted as they pass through a trap box and with the use of sonar. Migrating Coho that enter the trap box are sampled before being released upstream to continue their migration. Data collected includes length, sex, and origin (hatchery versus natural). Handling the fish also provides an opportunity to assess their overall health. The study design and operational procedures ensure minimal disruption to Coho migration and aim to reduce stress as much as possible. The majority of Coho migrate past the site unimpeded, through an opening in the fence, and are captured by the sonar unit. The injury rate of fish in the trap is very low; less than 0.2% of fish, on average, passing through the site display fresh wounds. This project is NWSFA's top priority during Coho migration and obtaining quality data to inform fisheries management decisions is the main objective.
