Documentary planned about Darius Sam

Vancouver director Amar Chebib — on the heels of his wildly successful *Joe Buffalo* short film, which has seen skateboard star Tony Hawke join as an executive producer — has set his sights next on Darius Sam, 'a 21-year-old prodigy ultra-runner from Lower Nicola First Nation, just outside of Merritt, BC.'

Chebib explains that the story is similar in some ways to Joe's in that the subject also had a very challenging upbringing, "with all the cards stacked against him."

BC seeks to decriminalize small amounts of illicit drugs

BC is the first province to seek an exemption from Health Canada under Section 56(1) of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act, to remove criminal penalties for people who possess small amounts of illicit drugs for personal use.

If approved by the federal government, the exemption would help reduce the fear and shame associated with substance use that prevents people from seeking care.

Since the Province declared a public health emergency in 2016, 7700 British Columbians have died because of a toxic drug supply. Prior to the outbreak of COVID-19, BC saw a decrease in death due to toxic drugs. However, the COVID-19 public health emergency reversed this trend, causing toxic drug poisoning deaths to reach an all-time high.

"Criminalizing members of our communities who use drugs has resulted in decades of causing further harms to many who are already suffering from mental or physical health challenges and/or the effects of emotional or physical trauma," said Lisa Lapointe, B.C.'s chief coroner. "Decriminalization will help shift our focus from punishment, which has resulted in social isolation, stigma and fear, toward a medical model that recognizes substance use as a health issue. This is an important step that, combined with increased access to safe supply and implementation of an evidence-based model of treatment and recovery, will help to save lives."

Global Covid-19 death toll surpasses 5 million, likely more

The global death toll from COVID-19 topped five million on Monday, less than two years into a crisis that has not only devastated poor countries but also humbled wealthy ones with first-rate health-care systems.

The death toll, as tallied by Johns Hopkins University, rivals the number of people killed in battles among countries since 1950, according to estimates from the Peace Research Institute Oslo. Globally, COVID-19 is now the third-leading cause of death, after heart disease and stroke.

The staggering figure is almost certainly an undercount because of limited testing and people dying at home without medical attention, especially in poor parts of the world.

The South American continent's death toll hovers near 1.2 million, with Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia and Peru all ranking among the 20 countries with the highest per capita death counts globally.

In North America, there have been more than 1.1 million official deaths due to COVID-19, primarily in the U.S. and Mexico. Canada has been hit by distressing outbreaks in long-term care facilities that have resulted in the significant majority of the 28,717 COVID-19 deaths.

Australia and New Zealand, with their stringent lockdowns, longest-lasting travel restrictions, low-density populations, favourable outdoor climate and relative isolation from the rest of the world, have seen 1,743 people dying from COVID-19 in Australia, and 28 in New Zealand.

The Nicola Watershed Stewardship & Fisheries Authority of the Scw'exm Tribal Council

Coho salmon enumeration activities Coldwater River at Voght Park — Until late November —

This project occurs annually in partnership with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and provides important information on Interior Fraser Coho. Coho are counted as they pass through a trap box and with the use of sonar. Migrating Coho that enter the trap box are sampled before being released upstream to continue their migration. Data collected includes length, sex, and origin (hatchery versus natural). Handling the fish also provides an opportunity to assess their overall health. The study design and operational procedures ensure minimal disruption to Coho migration and aim to reduce stress as much as possible. The majority of Coho migrate past the site unimpeded, through an opening in the fence, and are captured by the sonar unit. The injury rate of fish in the trap is very low; less than 0.2% of fish, on average, passing through the site display fresh wounds. This project is NWSFA's top priority during Coho migration and obtaining quality data to inform fisheries management decisions is the main objective.
