Mudslides, flooding & travel advisories

The BC Interior found itself with only one route to & from the Lower Mainland yesterday, as was the case in the summer — with only Hwy 3 open.

The 'atmospheric river' brought heavy rains which have caused mudslides that have closed the Coquihalla from Merritt to Hope, and Hwy 1 for a time yesterday afternoon between Hope & 4km south of Jackass Mountain Summit — though that road re-opened to traffic later, with a travel advisory for debris in water.

At drivebc.ca's last Coquihalla update yesterday at 2:30pm, both directions remained closed, with the only alternate route listed via Highway 3. The next update won't be until today at noon.

Meanwhile there is also a travel advisory for Hwy 1 from Spences Bridge to Lytton, due to the risk of sudden debris flows in fire affected areas. The forecast is for heavy rain through Tuesday.

Hwy 1 also has a travel advisory from Hope to Chilliwack because of mudslide events & flooding, as well as Hwy 7.

Coho salmon enumeration activities Coldwater River at Voght Park
 — Until late November —

This project occurs annually in partnership with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and provides important information on Interior Fraser Coho. Coho are counted as they pass through a trap box and with the use of sonar. Migrating Coho that enter the trap box are sampled before being released upstream to continue their migration. Data collected includes length, sex, and origin (hatchery versus natural). Handling the fish also provides an opportunity to assess their overall health. The study design and operational procedures ensure minimal disruption to Coho migration and aim to reduce stress as much as possible. The majority of Coho migrate past the site unimpeded, through an opening in the fence, and are captured by the sonar unit. The injury rate of fish in the trap is very low; less than 0.2% of fish, on average, passing through the site display fresh wounds. This project is NWSFA's top priority during Coho migration and obtaining quality data to inform fisheries management decisions is the main objective.

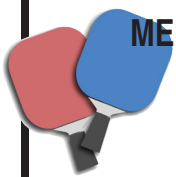
