Elizabeth Laird 1948-2021

A longtime radio station owner who used her business to champion industry, tourism and non-profit organizations has died after a valiant effort to overcome cancer. Elizabeth Ann Laird (nee Futter) passed away Friday December 31st 2021, surrounded by her family. She was 73.

Daughter of John and Betty Futter (survived by her brothers Peter and Ian and pre-deceased by brother Michael) born in Waterloo, Ontario December 9th 1948, Elizabeth enjoyed a loving family and childhood with travel overseas starting at a young age; also sharing with anyone the thrill of seeing The Beatles at the CNE in 1964. Elizabeth moved with her parents to British Columbia in 1967 after completing high school.

It was in BC, Elizabeth met her life partner David Laird in 1968 and the two were married May 31st, 1969 in Sidney, BC.

Moving to the BC Interior in 1970, the couple settled first in Salmon Arm then Enderby; where they built a home and resided until 1978 before moving to Armstrong.

While raising two sons in the North Okanagan, Elizabeth became involved in many activities such as Cubs and Scouts, slo-pitch, bowling leagues, church activities and more. Upon having a larger property, she was also able to pursue her lifelong love of horses. Elizabeth's jovial spirit and can-do attitude made her a much sought after volunteer for community groups and organizations.

In 1982, the family moved to Nicola Ranch near Merritt, BC and immediately picked up making new connections and contributions to the community in the Nicola Valley. In 1984 Elizabeth became the owner and operator of IADE Garden Centre (named from "Jeffrey, Andrew, David, Elizabeth") and forged many new friendships as a result.

With the family moving into Merritt in 1985, "Liz" (as she was known by her many friends, business colleagues and community connections) was elected as a School District 58 trustee (1986-1996) while operating the garden centre until 1993.

Elizabeth's introduction to the radio industry came through her son Andrew, a former morning show host at CJNL 1230 in Merritt. Elizabeth joined the "Radio NL" family and in 1994 became an investor in Merritt Broadcasting until becoming the full owner in 2016 of what is now Q101; the only female independent broadcast owner/ operator in BC. Elizabeth gave many students and broadcasters their first opportunity at Q101 and has always been proud of what they would go on to accomplish.

Moving to their beloved Nicola Lake home in 2007, Elizabeth and David began enjoying travelling the world on more adventures that would take them to dozens of countries over the next decade.

Even with the many challenges of running a business, Liz continued to find time to serve her community. She was elected as the first female president of the Merritt Rotary Club in the 1990's, served on the board of the Merritt Chamber of Commerce and contributed to many community partners.

Elizabeth's inspiration, guidance, love and her spirit will live on in the lives of her loving husband of 52 years David, her sons Andrew (Craig) and Jeffrey (Aleece) and

A COVID-19 test is not recommended if:

- You have no symptoms, even if you are a close contact of someone who has tested positive.
- You are fully vaccinated (two doses), experiencing mild
- symptoms and can manage your illness at home. Self-isolate for seven days. Notify your close contacts so they can self-monitor for symptoms.

A COVID-19 test is recommended if:

- You are experiencing one or more of the following symptoms: fever or chills; cough; loss of sense of smell or taste; or difficulty breathing.
- You have experienced one or more of the following symptoms for longer than 24 hours with no improvement: sore throat; loss of appetite; headache or body aches; extreme fatigue; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea.

If you feel unwell and are unsure about your symptoms, contact your health care provider or call 8-1-1.

Rapid COVID-19 tests will be available at Interior Health Community Collection Centres (testing centres), including NV Hospital & Health Centre. Where available, rapid tests may be provided to individuals experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and according to risk factors.

When to get a COVID-19 test: **Updated** guidelines

IH WIDE - As COVID-19 activity increases across B.C., guidance for when to get a COVID-19 test has been updated.

A COVID-19 test is not recommended if:

 You have no symptoms, even if you are a close contact of someone who has tested positive.

 You are fully vaccinated (two doses), experiencing mild symptoms and can manage your illness at home. Self-isolate for seven days. Notify your close contacts so they can self-monitor for symptoms.

A COVID-19 test is recommended if:

 You are experiencing one or more of the following symptoms: fever or chills; cough; loss of sense of smell or taste; or difficulty breathing.

· You have experienced one or more of the following symptoms for longer than 24 hours with no improvement: sore throat; loss of appetite; headache or body aches; extreme fatigue; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea.

If you feel unwell and are unsure about your symptoms, contact your health care provider or call 8-1-1.

Rapid COVID-19 tests will be available at Interior Health Community Collection Centres (testing centres), including NV Hospital & Health Centre. Where available, rapid tests may be provided to individuals experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and according to risk factors.
