Coq preparations for Spring freshet & permanent repairs

Permanent repairs from November's
flood damage are expected to begin later
this year, but in the meantime, work is
underway on the Coquihalla Highway
to prepare for spring runoff.

The Ministry of Transportation and
Infrastructure continues to add to the
initial response work done on the high-
ways damaged by floods, including sig-
nificant rip rap (rock) placement at key
locations, as well as slope armouring,
drainage improvements and increased
culvert capacity, as well as close mon-
itoring. MOTI also notes that wildfire
damage can increase runoff and impact
overall soil stability. A pair of wildfires
merged near the Coq last summer, and at
one point the route was closed because
of flames and smoke dangerously close
to the road.

MOTI is currently in Phase 1 of its
response to washed away and damaged
sections of the highway. That work is an-
ticipated to be completed in the spring,
including the reinforcements in prepara-
tion for freshet.

Phase 2 will include the design and
construction of long-term repairs and
will begin in the upcoming construction
season at the earliest.

NVIT partners with City of Merritt

The City of Merritt and the Nicola Val-
ley Institute of Technology are partner-
ing to bring a new training opportunity
to the community. The Workplace Skills
Training Program is free for participants
through the financial support of the Pro-
vince of British Columbia. Participants
must pre-register through NVIT by Feb.
28 as space is limited.

The Workplace Skills Training Pro-
gram will be delivered over 5-weeks on
Friday mornings from Mar 4, -April 1, at
the NVIT Campus. The training will cover
topics such as Communication Skills,
Decision Making, Problem Solving, Customer
Service, and more. This program is
ideal for workers who are either enter-
ing the workforce or transitioning into a
workplace where these skills are essential
to help achieve job success.

The need for this type of skills training
was identified in the Thriving Communi-
ties Labour Market Report which was re-
leased in February 2020. Implementation
of the report recommendations has been
delayed due to public health restrictions
associated with the COVID-19 Pandemic.
The City of Merritt & NVIT have been
working to make the Workplace Skills
Training program a reality since Sept 2021.

"We are so fortunate to have an edu-
cational institution like NVIT that brings
high quality training programs to our
community," states Stephanie Moore,
Economic Recovery Advisor for the City
of Merritt. "It is great to work in partner-
ship with the City of Merritt to provide
front line workers with the opportunity
to enhance their skills and increase their
employability which will help to sustain
businesses in our community" states Jen-
nifer Lisle, Student Transitions Advisor at
the Nicola Valley Institute of Technology.

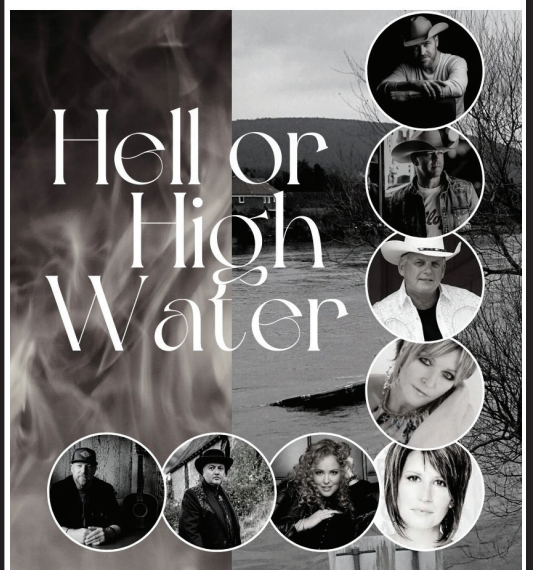

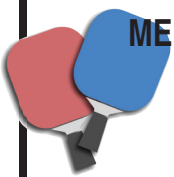
