Coq preparations for Spring freshet & permanent repairs

Permanent repairs from November's flood damage are expected to begin later this year, but in the meantime, work is underway on the Coquihalla Highway to prepare for spring runoff.

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure continues to add to the initial response work done on the highways damaged by floods, including significant rip rap (rock) placement at key locations, as well as slope armouring, drainage improvements and increased culvert capacity., as well as close monitoring. MOTI also notes that wildfire damage can increase runoff and impact overall soil stability. A pair of wildfires merged near the Coq last summer, and at one point the route was closed because of flames and smoke dangerously close to the road.

MOTI is currently in Phase 1 of its response to washed away and damaged sections of the highway. That work is anticipated to be completed in the spring, including the reinforcements in preparation for freshet.

Phase 2 will include the design and construction of long-term repairs and will begin in the upcoming construction season at the earliest.

NVIT partners with City of Merritt





When to get a COVID-19 test: **Updated** guidelines

IH WIDE - As COVID-19 activity increases across B.C., guidance for when to get a COVID-19 test has been updated.

A COVID-19 test is not recommended if:

You have no symptoms, even if you are a close contact

of someone who has tested positive. You are fully vaccinated (two doses), experiencing mild

symptoms and can manage your illness at home. Self-isolate for seven days. Notify your close contacts so they can self-monitor for symptoms.

A COVID-19 test is recommended if:

 You are experiencing one or more of the following symptoms: fever or chills; cough; loss of sense of smell or taste; or difficulty breathing.

· You have experienced one or more of the following symptoms for longer than 24 hours with no improvement: sore throat; loss of appetite; headache or body aches; extreme fatigue; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea.

If you feel unwell and are unsure about your symptoms,

contact your health care provider or call 8-1-1. Rapid COVID-19 tests will be available at Interior Health Community Collection Centres (testing centres), including NV Hospital & Health Centre. Where available, rapid tests may be provided to individuals experiencing symptoms of
