Grounbreaking on old visitor centre

Yesterday, local first nations along
with municipal & provincial partners
held a ground breaking ceremony at
Gateway 286. The project has been in the
works for about the past 30 years.

The land it sits on is part of Nla-
ka'pamux and Sylix traditional territo-
ries, part of which was developed in 2005
by the Province as a rest stop and visitor
info centre. The centre was closed in 2018
after which the Province transferred 11.6
hectares of the land back to the First Na-
tions as part of a protocol agreement fo-
cused on strengthening support for local
First Nations' economic development.

The first phase of the new develop-
ment, including approx. 30,000 sq. ft. of
commercial retail and services, will also
include redevelopment of the Merritt rest
stop. The remaining land, transferred to
Spayum Holdings in 2021, will present
additional development opportunities
for the First Nations in the future.

The project is on a 20-year plan, to be
developed in 2 parts. Part 1 includes 3.6
hectares and will include administrative
office, artisan studio, brewing & distill-
ing, a drive-through, filling station, a
food establishment, gallery & museum,
a liquor establishment, park, convenience
store, and truck travel centre.

There's no set timeline for the project
to be completed, but the first phase of
construction has begun.

Deadline for TNRD wildfire debris removal program

TNRD property owners who lost
structures as a result of wildfires in 2021
may be eligible for reimbursement for
cleaning up debris on their property.
Residents are reminded that the program
was launched in January, and residents
looking to register are asked to contact
the TNRD by March 25. To register, call
377-6312, or email tnrdrecovery@tnrd.ca.
Please include your contact information
and address of impacted property.

Through the program, the TNRD is
able to reimburse property owners who
have incurred expenses for debris remov-
al. Proof of payment is required for re-
imbursement of wildfire debris removal
completed by private property owners.

This program focuses on rural Elec-
toral Areas of the TNRD impacted by
wildfires in 2021, such as Monte Lake,
Tranquille, and Botanie Valley. Debris
removal in Lytton is being coordinated
separately by the Village of Lytton.

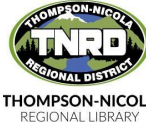

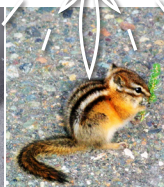
