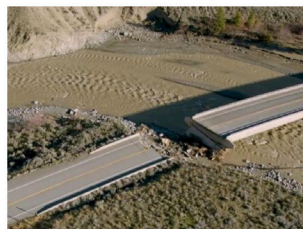

Hwy 8 repair update

As of Monday, temporary repairs are
complete at 6 locations along Hwy 8 be-
tween Merritt & Spences Bridge. Con-
struction has started on another 9, and 8
more sites are planned for the near future.

The Ministry of Transportation and
Infrastructure anticipates this phase
—emergency access and temporary
construction — will be complete in the
spring. Most residents along the corridor
have returned home thanks to the work
and progress made by crews.

Now, they are working on forecast-
ing a long-term repair schedule for the
phases of work to follow. They are also
preparing for the spring thaw, freshet.
Many of the temporary repairs that have
been completed include reinforcing and
armouring parts of the highway with
additional riprap. This will make the re-
paired sections of highway more resilient
to future flooding. They are also moni-
toring conditions as temperatures warm
and melt begins.

Int. Savings supports Ukrainian refugees

Interior Savings is waiving processing
fees for wire transfers that are intended
to provide financial assistance to the
Ukraine and neighbouring countries —
Poland, Romania, Hungary & Slovakia.

And, with the announcement that
Canada is opening its borders to assist
those fleeing Ukraine, Interior Savings
has also made a commitment of \$5000 to
help support Ukrainian refugees and will
work with local partners to determine the
best way to distribute those funds.

For anyone transferring money to
Ukraine and surrounding countries to
support humanitarian efforts, fees will
be waived until June 30, 2022, at which
time the program will be reviewed.

Interior Savings is encouraging those
that can, to lend their support. There are

Free rapid tests for people 30+

Since Monday, rapid antigen test
kits are now available to people aged
30 years and older through community
pharmacies.

Eligible individuals can pick up one
kit of 5 tests every 28 days from partici-
pating pharmacies at no cost. Individuals
must present their personal health num-
ber when picking up the kit.

Individuals should pick up a test kit when not having symptoms of illness to use
at a future time when having symptoms of illness. Guidelines for testing continue to
indicate tests should be used for symptomatic individuals.

As of March 17, almost 7.6 million tests have been shipped to pharmacy distrib-
utors with more than 2.3 million rapid tests dispensed through the more than 1,300
participating pharmacies. So far, more than 30.2 million tests have been distributed in
BC. And they are expecting to receive more than 2.5 million tests from the federal
govt in the next few weeks, to be able to distribute more tests to members of the
broader community.

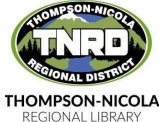

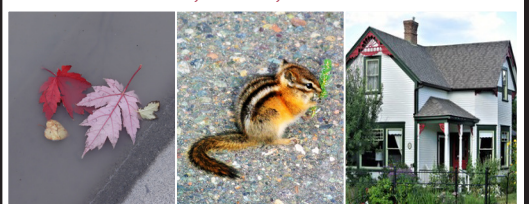

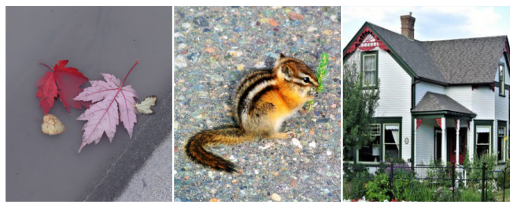
