Happy birthday, Merritt Morning Mirror!

Not an April Fool's Day goes by that
I can forget April 1, 1995 when the *Mer-
ritt Morning Mirror* hit the streets of this
'hamlet', as Gordon Cockle would often
call it...

Gord had a vision & a dream for a type
of media where he could just be himself.
He'd tried the conventional media, and
shone there too, except for the occasion-
al 'f' word. These were the days before
social media when you had to have an
outstanding opinion & perspective to
make a mark. And Gord certainly made
his mark! For the 2 (too-short) years that
Gord published the *MMMirror*, this town
was on fire — and he had set it alight! He
was a gem, a literary great, and took this
town with him on his rocketing path to
epic story-telling.

Gord passed from this world just over
2 years ago, a great loss to the fabric of
the town. After all this time — 27 years
— what is the proportion of Merrittonians
who remember? About half, I'd guess.

I've always thought that the popu-
lation here is like a current... there are
those who come through on their way
somewhere else, and those who have
gotten stuck in the eddies of this town.

I can now consider myself one of
the latter. I started with Gord when he
launched the *MMMirror's* sister publi-
cation, the *MMMarket*, in 1996; and then
bought the business in 1997. And now,
it's 30 years for me this year, living in
Merritt! Half of my life! and 25 years do-
ing the *MMMarket* — oh, my! Unbeliev-
able... and time well-spent, I'd say.

I remember the early 90s as a very ex-
citing time in Merritt. Start of the *Mirror*
& the crazy stories, start of the music fes-
tival, houses available to buy for under
\$100,000 — lol, those days are gone!

But Gord's partner Jano Howarth
has posted some of his writings, which
are still an unparalleled treasure for this

500k for hard-hit Merritt & Princeton

People living in Merritt and Prince-
ton will benefit from rural development
grants to help them recover from the ef-
fects of climate-related events.

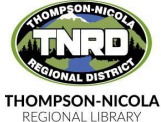

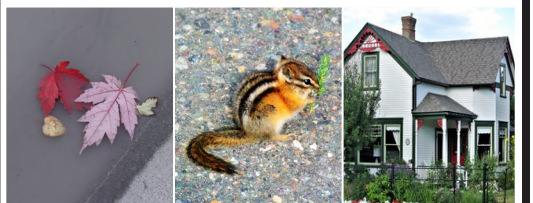

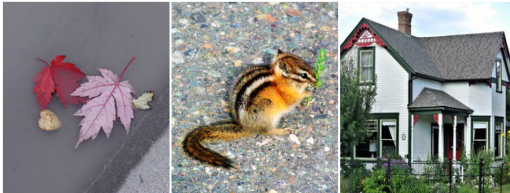
