### Coq closed Monday onvernigh

DriveBC reported multiple vehicle incidents in the Snowshed Hill area of the Coquihalla Hwy Monday night around 11pm. Environment Canada had issued a snowstorm warning on the weekend. The road reopened 7:30am April 5.

### Teck contributes \$2.5 million to RIH

Royal Inland Hospital Foundation announced that Teck Resources has made a \$2.5 million contribution towards the hospital's new emergency department, which will feature the installation of innovative antimicrobial copper surfaces and equipment to help protect patients and healthcare workers.

When complete, the newly renovated emergency department will offer expanded care and enhanced patient outcomes in one of the busiest emergency departments in BC's Interior region. The facility upgrades will result in reduced wait times for access to treatment for people when they need it most.

This donation builds on more than 25 years of support to Royal Inland Hospital Foundation by Teck and its employees at Teck Highland Valley Copper Operations. This support is also the latest in a series of contributions made to hospitals across BC such as St. Paul's Hospital, Vancouver General Hospital and Kootenay Boundary Regional Hospital which include installation of antimicrobial copper surfaces as part of Teck's Copper & Health program.

The redevelopment of the Royal Inland Hospital emergency department is a part of Interior Health's Phil & Jennie Gagliardi Tower Phase 2 renovations. Construction of the new Teck Emergency Department begins in July 2022 and will take place in phases, with the department remaining open to patients for the duration of the project. Phase 2 renovations are scheduled to be complete in 2026.

### 'Ember' & wildfire preparedness for children

The Library is partnering with FireSmart BC to enhance wildfire preparedness & resiliency through a series of children's programs.

All of the programs feature Ember: FireSmart's new mascot. As a fox, Ember personifies alertness, adaptability, intelligence, and community mindedness. She encourages us all to do the same.

April: monthly colouring contest will feature Ember! Colouring pages can be picked up at any TNRL branch, and coloured by anyone aged 12 and younger. Thanks to our partners at FireSmart BC, each branch will have an Ember plush toy to give away as the monthly draw prize! Enter the contest by showing a completed colouring page to staff at the library desk.

May: Children can take home a free Ember Activity Package from any of our branches, which includes colouring book, crayons, sticker, a magnet, and info about how to make your home FireSmart.

June: Borrow one of our new Wildfire Resiliency Literacy Kits, designed for children aged 3 to 8, aimed to provide children with a way to explore and learn about a topic. Resiliency is the ability to cope with the mental and emotional stress of a crisis. Through learning and exploring the topic of wildfires in this kit, children will be more prepared and resilient in the event of a wildfire.

### Spring COVID-19 booster vaccine

The Province continues with previously announced plans to further lift COVID-19 restrictions, while protecting those most at risk with the launch of the spring booster vaccine program.

To protect seniors and Elders, the Province has begun rolling out a spring booster vaccine program for seniors in long-term care and assisted living facilities. Community-dwelling seniors over the age of 70 and Indigenous people over the age of 55 will also begin receiving their invitations for their spring booster dose – a new booster dose for eligible seniors who received their third shot six months ago or more. People can use their invitation to schedule their appointment in health authority clinics or at participating pharmacies. A call centre will also continue to be available for those who are not able to book online.

Starting on Friday, April 8, 12:01am, changes will take place:

- Showing the BC Vaccine Card proof of vaccination to access events, services and businesses will no longer be required, though individual businesses and organizations can choose to continue requiring the BC Vaccine Card on their premises.
- The remainder of the Workplace Safety Order will expire, which means that businesses are transitioning back to communicable disease plans to reduce risk of all communicable disease.
- The requirement for students residing in residence to be fully vaccinated under the Post-secondary Institution Housing COVID-19 Preventative Measures Order will be repealed.
- The easing of restrictions is based on ongoing and careful review of data by the provincial health officer and the BC Centre for Disease Control. Everyone will adjust to the changes in restrictions at their own pace, and it is important to be respectful of other people's comfort levels.




