Changing to 'surveillance' for Covid

As of April 8, 12:01am

- BC Vaccine Card no longer required
- Businesses transition from COVID-19 safety plan to communicable disease plan.
- Post-secondary residence vaccine requirement lifted

BC shifts from daily to weekly reporting

Beginning yesterday, COVID-19 dashboards and reports issued by the British Columbia Centre for Disease Control will be updated on weekly basis, at www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19/data

The new reports will focus on key measures of severity and trends over time, similar to how other communicable diseases are reported. Officials will continue to provide the data required to guide public health decision-making. Data will be updated Thursday afternoons and will provide info from the past full week, from the previous Sunday to Saturday. The first reports and updates will include data up to the week of March 27 to April 2, 2022.

The easing of restrictions is based on ongoing and careful review of data by the provincial health officer and the BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC). Everyone will adjust to the changes in restrictions at their own pace, and it is important to be respectful of other people's comfort levels.

The new COVID-19 reporting approach aligns with a shift away from a "case-management" model to a "surveillance" approach. It is similar to how government monitors for other serious respiratory illnesses through FluWatch.

On September 8, 2021, an Abbotsford man was caught in a stolen vehicle driving on the Coquihala Highway past Merritt. On March 31, 2022, Mr. Tyler Klutskow pleaded guilty to Possession of Stolen Property, Dangerous Operation of a Motor Vehicle and Fail to Comply with Release Order. He received 365 days in jail, probation for 1 year and a 12 month driving prohibition.

Merritt woman gets conditional discharge after a home invasion

On March 21, 2021, Merritt Front Line Officers were called to a home in the 2800 block of Cranna Crescent. It was alleged that Ms. Christeena Clarke had broken into the home and assaulted a victim over a personal dispute. On March 31, 2022, in Supreme Court, Ms. Clarke pleaded guilty to being Unlawfully in a Dwelling House and Assault. She received a conditional discharge for both offences, probation for 18 months and was ordered to pay a \$200 victim surcharge.

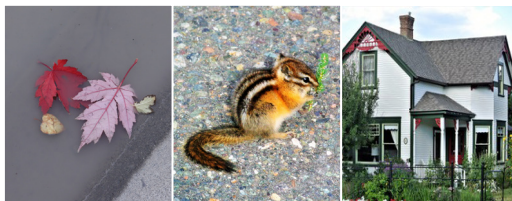
