Mayor Brown front & centre at Canucks game

Mayor Linda Brown took part in a ceremonial puck drop during Saturday's game against the San Jose Sharks, along with other honourees including the mayors of Abbotsford and Princeton, members of the Armed Forces, representatives of first responder groups, health care professionals, educators and other essential workers. It was part of the Canucks & BCLC's *Community Heroes Night* "to honour the countless heroes who have contributed to their communities throughout the pandemic, floods, wildfires, and other challenges facing British Columbia this year."

Airborn silt dust

The City of Merritt, in collaboration with the Min. of Environment and Climate Change Strategy and Interior Health, issued an Information Bulletin regarding high concentrations of coarse particulate matter in the air, related to ongoing flood clean up and recovery efforts.

As we have seen since it started to dry up, there is increased dust across the community due to the ongoing active clean up is occurring or down-wind of areas of exposed soils.

They recommend avoiding areas of blowing dust when possible, which are of particular concern for those with chronic conditions such as asthma, COPD, heart disease, and diabetes; respiratory infections such as COVID-19, pregnant women, infants, and older adults.

There are 2 monitoring stations in town — a weather station on Parcel St. & a mobile air monitoring laboratory on Nicola Ave. across the alley from City Hall. This last shows that coarse particulate matter (PM10) — dust with diameters between 2.5 & 10 micrometers (µm) — has been spiking up to 130 µg/m3. [The acceptable limit is 50 µg/m3 averaged out over a 24hr period].
