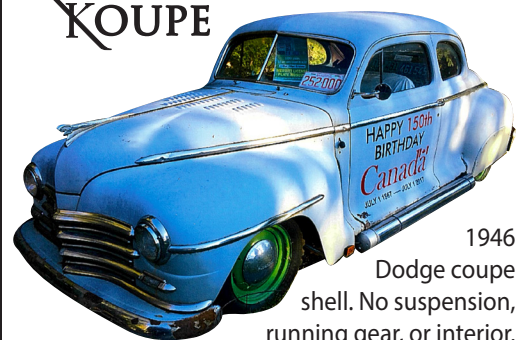

Permanent repairs to the Coq & Hwy 1

Permanent repairs to flood-damaged sections of the Coquihalla & Highway 1 will soon be underway.

The contract for development and early construction work on sections of the Coquihalla between Hope and Merritt has been awarded to KEA5, a joint venture between Peter Kiewit & Sons and Emil Anderson Construction.

The work to return the Coquihalla to the previous full, 4-lane capacity will begin this summer and take place at 3 sites:

- Bottletop Bridges, 50 kms south of Merritt;
- Juliet Bridges, 3 kms south of Bottletop;
- Jessica Bridges, 48 kms south of Juliet.

Work is expected to be substantially complete this winter. All efforts will be made to minimize traffic disruptions during peak travel hours, and crews will work overnight when possible.

The ministry has also issued a request for proposals (RFP) for damaged sections along Hwy 1 through the Fraser Canyon. The RFP process invites select contractors who qualified through the Highway Reinstatement Program request for qualifications (RFQ) process to take part in the competitive selection process to design and construct the permanent repairs needed at: Falls Creek Bridge, 55 kilometres south of Spences Bridge; Tank Hill Crossing, 23 kilometres south of Spences Bridge; and Nicomen River Bridge, 19 kilometres south of Spences Bridge. The RFP for the repair project will close Sept. 14, with the contract awarded shortly after.

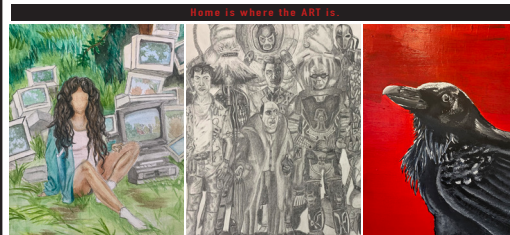

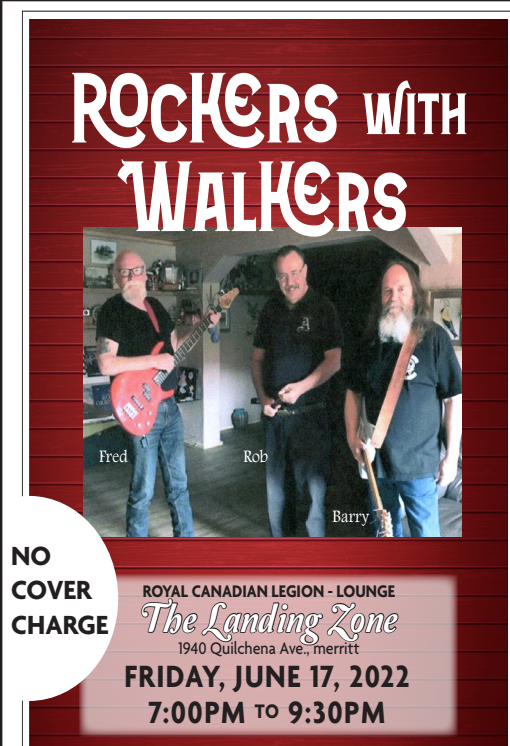
