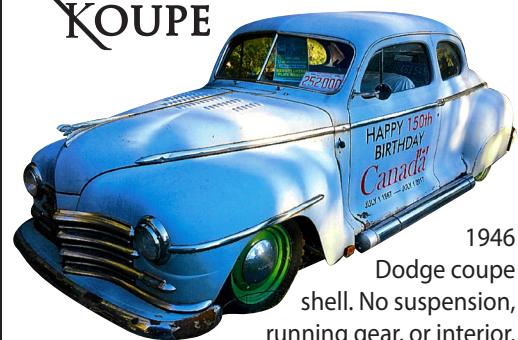

Hospital reopened Friday afternoon after gas odour scare

The hospital and emergency department at NV Hospital & Health Ctre was closed from about 10am 'til 3:30pm while authorities checked out the cause of air sensor alarms, triggered by gas coming out of a sewage drain of a bathroom.

Officials say the gas in a blocked pipe reacted with drain cleaning fluid, setting off the alarm.

Ten patients were temporarily evacuated, transferred to other locations for their safety. There were no injuries and the building was ventilated with both the Merritt Fire Department and Fortis BC in attendance, confirming the air was free of any "gases of concern."

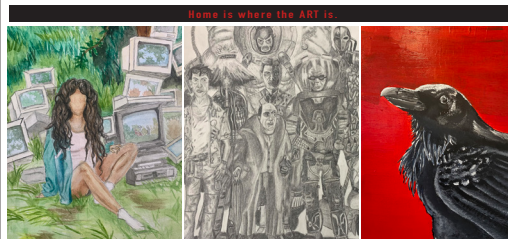
