No fireworks for Canada Day

Last year, the City of Merritt fireworks show for Canada Day was cancelled at the last minute. The Interior of BC was being ravaged by an extreme heat wave and our neighbouring community of Lytton had suffered a devastating conflagration. That fire and others continued to burn out in our fire zone for several weeks/months. This last-minute cancellation created liability, coordination, & costs to store these fireworks for several months until the City Halloween fireworks show.

Sky McKeown the Director of Recreation and Facilities said "this cancellation is due to several other factors, including a wet spring that is building a foundation of grasses and other foliage that will be getting tall now that the sun has come out. "We are playing it safe and being proactive in preventing anything unnecessary from happening," he said. "There are also still several people in our community trying to mentally recover from recent devastating events and we are not looking to add to their anxiety by hosting the fireworks portion of the Canada Day celebrations".

"It's just for this year at this time as it is hard to say what's going to happen for future Canada Day firework show celebrations. As of right now the 2022 City Halloween Fireworks Show is being planned for".

There are still big plans for the Canada Day celebration activities on July 1. They will begin with a **pancake breakfast at the Civic Center 7-11am. Starting at 11am Rotary Park will host: activities with the Arts Council, Canadian trivia games, kids bouncy castle, and games with Q-101. Noon Royal Canadian Legion Flag ceremony with speeches and cupcakes. The event will round out with popular Music in the Park featuring The Doug James Band 3-5pm.**

Armed Robbery suspects caught

Two armed robbery suspects were caught by police after robbing Canco Merritt in the 2300 block of Nicola Ave.

On June 16, Merritt Front Line Officers were called to a gas station in the 2300 block of Nicola Ave. as it was alleged 2 suspects had robbed the store with hand guns and assaulted the clerk. Police Dog Services were called out to assist. One of the suspects was located and apprehended by the police dog after a short chase. He was found to be in possession of an air pistol, a long serrated knife with a gut hook, other various items and what is believed to be the stolen merchandise from the robbery. The suspect was held and then released on conditions at the request of Crown Counsel.

Through further investigation police identified the alleged second suspect as Mr. Timothy James Molnar. On June 17, 2022, Mr. Molnar was located and arrested by police. He was found to be in possession of an air pistol and what is believed to be more stolen merchandise from the robbery. On June 18, Mr. Molnar was charged with Robbery and held in custody to appear in Court on June 27, 2022.
