Category 2 open fire prohibition

Effective at 12 noon on Friday, July 15, Category 2 open fires as well as other equipment and activities will be prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre. These prohibitions are in addition to the Category 3 open fire prohibition implemented on June 30. They will remain in effect until noon on Oct. 15, or until the orders are rescinded.

Anyone conducting Category 2 open fires within the Kamloops Fire Centre's jurisdiction must extinguish those fires by the July 15 deadline.

Specific prohibited open fires and equipment and activities include Category 2 open fires; Category 3 open fires; Fireworks; Sky Lanterns and, Burn Barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description, except when used for a campfire as defined by the Wildfire Regulation.

Campfires, as defined in the Wildfire Regulation are not being prohibited at this time. Responsible campfire use follows the campfire regulations.

Anyone found in contravention of an open burning prohibition may be issued a ticket for \$1,150, required to pay an administrative penalty of up to \$10,000 or, if convicted in court, fined up to \$100,000 and / or sentenced to one year in jail. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person responsible may be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.





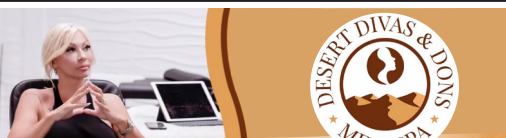
