## Kamloops Fire Centre & City of Merritt ban campfires

Effective at 12pm (noon) on Thursday, August 4, campfires, will be prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre — including small confined fire permits rescinded until the ban ends, in and around the City of Merritt — to help prevent human-caused wildfires and protect public safety. This campfire prohibition will remain in effect until noon on Oct. 15, or until the orders are rescinded.

The Kamloops Fire Centre is currently experiencing hot and dry conditions and fire danger ratings are generally “high” or “extreme” throughout the fire centre. Category 2 and Category 3 open fires and Section 12 Equipment and Activities (listed below) are already prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre.

Banned are: campfires as defined in the Wildfire Regulation; category 2 open fire as defined in the Wildfire Regulation; category 3 open fire as defined in the Wildfire Regulation; fireworks; sky lanterns; burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description; binary exploding targets; tiki and similar kind of torches; chimineas, outdoor stoves and other portable campfire apparatuses not CSA or ULC approved.

## Sagebrush ranks 13th in 'top 100 courses in Canada'

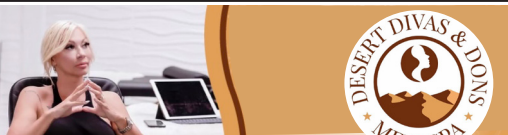
