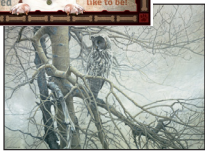

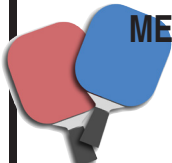

during the Lytton River Festival

Since June 2021, devastating fires and
floods have left many community mem-
bers with little time to evacuate or recover.
The many artists and crafters residing
in Lytton and the Fraser Canyon area lost
their means of income, self-expression
and creative outlet. The loss of supplies
after years of accumulation will take time
to replace and not everyone has the ability
to prioritize funds to replenishing their

September 19 Nat'l day of mourning to mark Queen's funeral

Premier John Horgan, in response to
the federal government declaring a na-
tional holiday to mark the Queen's fu-
neral: "Our government will follow the
lead of the federal government and join
with other provinces in observing the
national day of mourning to mark the
Queen's funeral.

"The national holiday will be ob-
served Monday, Sept. 19 by federal em-
ployees. We have advised provincial
public-sector employers to honour this
day in recognition of the obligations
around federal holidays in the vast ma-
jority of provincial collective agreements.

"K-12 public schools and public
post-secondary institutions, and most
Crown corporations will be closed. We
encourage private-sector employers to
find a way to recognize or reflect on the day in a way that is appropriate for their em-
ployees. This will be a national day to reflect on the incredible life of Canada's Queen
and the longest-serving monarch in British history."

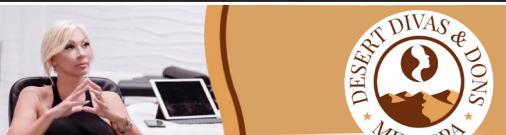
