Woman missing from Mamette Lk Rd

On Saturday, October 1, Merritt RCMP received a missing person report. Jacqueline McDermott was reported missing by family, as she has not been seen or heard from since Thurs., September 29.



Police have learned that on Sept 30, Jacqueline had planned to attend a yoga retreat near Merritt but left after a short time. Her vehicle, which appears to have broken down, was located on Hwy 97C between Merritt and Logan Lake, and locals recall seeing her around her vehicle.

An extensive search on land and in air was conducted by RCMP Air Services, Police Dog Services and Search & Rescue, and no sign of Jacqueline has been found.

She is described as: Caucasian female, 22 years old, 5' 7 (170 cms), 111 lbs (50 kgs), Curly blonde hair, Fair complexion, Medium build, Nose piercing

Municipal election 2022 - for City Council Wendy Charney

I have lived in Merritt since 1974, and witnessed Merritt's ups and downs over the years. My platform is based on economic growth/development, infrastructure as well as transparency/accountability and affordability of housing.

Between 2016 and 2021 the population in Merritt decreased by 1.2%. The 2016 census placed Merritt the 10th slowest growing city in the province. With the development of light industry that have competitive wages, I believe that our City can grow. The tax base would then become larger and take the stress off residential taxes.

Affordability of housing has been addressed in part by rezoning and changing building regulations and requirements i.e. lot size, parking and density. But the City must make sure that the rezoning does not impact the present neighbourhood in a negative manner. Community input is a key factor. There are a number of initiatives presently in place for housing, unfortunately, with the rent based on demand throughout BC, it does not become affordable housing. The heaviest lifting for affordable housing must be done by the Federal and Provincial governments.

The infrastructure of the City must be addressed for the safety and well-being of the community. Dyking and rebuilding the Middlesborough Bridge must be paramount. Continual pressure by City Council at the Federal and Provincial level must continue. In the meantime we must focus on our roads and sidewalks.

Council must try to ensure that citizens are fully informed of what and why decisions are made. This can be done through regular social/media alerts. Council may be working hard on different aspects within the community, but the citizens are not kept abreast of these events unless they go to the Council meeting or watch it online. Accessibility of information must be improved and Council must not be evasive.

Tourism development must be stressed by Council through leadership and coordination. The RV Park must be rebuilt and if possible expanded to include Claybanks.

Italian plum jam no pectin

2½ lb. ripe Italian plums, quartered and pitted
2 lb. (4 cups) sugar
¼ cup fresh lemon juice
1 Tbsp. anise hyssop leaves, finely chopped (optional)

Wash, slice in half and pit your plums. Place the plums, sugar and lemon in a bowl, in the fridge for at least 8 hours. Remove the bowl and place the plums in their sugar syrup in a large sauce pan. Slowly simmer the plums, stirring continually, until it thickens up, check with a candy thermometer (should be 220 F).

Follow recommended water-bath-canning procedures to jar and preserve the jam for long-term storage. Or, let it cool completely, then refrigerate and serve immediately or within 2 weeks.

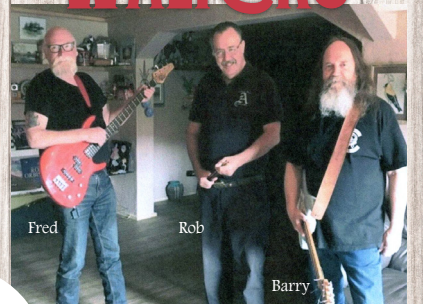
