Plum shrub

1 kg plums thinly sliced
2 cups unrefined sugar
1 teaspoon cardamom
seeds roughly crushed
1 tsp black peppercorns
roughly crushed
1-to-1 1/2 cups organic apple cider vinegar or white wine vinegar
sparkling water to serve



Combine sliced plums, sugar and spices in a glass bowl or container & mix well. Cover & place in fridge. Stir plums everyday for 4 days — the juice from the fruit & the sugar will create the syrup.

Strain out plums, then add vinegar to the syrup (1 cup of vinegar for lighter flavour, 1 1/2 cups if you like it stronger). Leave this for another day or two before drinking, or it can be served right away.

To serve, pour 1-2 tablespoons of syrup into a glass and top up with sparkling water. Or use in salad dressings, cocktails, or mocktails. The syrup will keep indefinitely in the fridge.

Flavour variation: combine 5 small cinnamon sticks; 4 cardamom pods, lightly crushed; 1 vanilla bean, seeds scraped; substitute quality white balsamic vinegar.

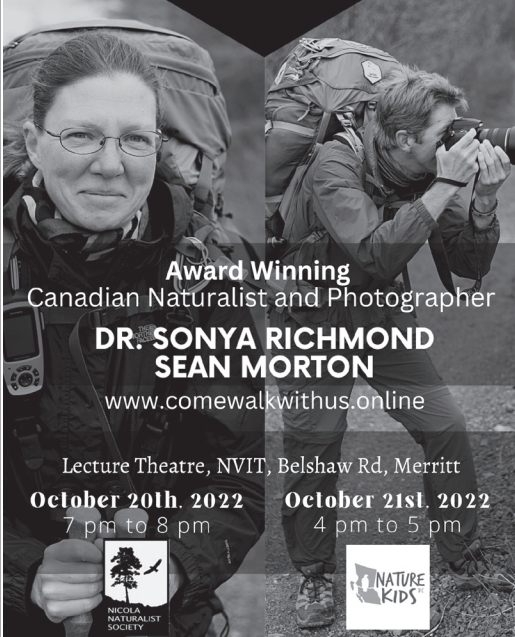
