'Suspects in mind, no arrests yet'

RCMP in Merritt say they have identified a group of suspects they believe are responsible for a series of early morning shootings that rocked the town and surrounding communities early Tuesday morning.

"It's very alarming in our community to have something like this happen. Very concerning," said Sgt. Josh Roda. "So we want to reiterate to the public that we believe these incidents are targeted and there is no further risk to the public."

In total, up to 100 rounds were fired off at locations on the Coldwater Indian Band reserve, at a mobile home park in Merritt, and on the reserve of the Lower Nicola Indian Band.

"We're still following the evidence and we're working on processing all the evidence we've gathered from different scenes, from vehicles, and we're trying to use that to hopefully work towards making arrests," said Roda.

Grants in lieu of taxes

The City of Merritt has received \$32,904 from the 'grants in lieu of property taxes' distributed every November, which reimburse local municipalities for the services they provide to the public and their support of local infrastructure, such as parks, municipally run sewers, roads and fire protection.

Grants cover land and property owned by the provincial government, such as office buildings, warehouses and courthouses. Schools and hospitals are exempt from paying municipal property taxes and are not part of the grants-in-lieu calculation. Also excluded from compensation under the Municipal Aid Act are provincial assets such as highways, forests, and parks or land under the control, management or administration of a Crown corporation.

The program includes 55 BC communities, which will benefit from approx. \$17.3 million in grants in lieu of municipal property taxes this year.

IIO clears Merritt RCMP in 2021 shootout

The Independent Investigations Office has cleared 4 RCMP officers of any wrongdoing after a shootout wounded Gerald Hartley Cooper and his 11-year old son during a pursuit around Merritt & Kelowna in 2021.

The IIO says Mounties who exchanged gunfire during a car chase between Merritt and Quilchena, injuring a man and his young son, did so only after being fired upon themselves.

The IIO decision was made public in December, 2021, but the release of the complete report was delayed until court proceedings against Cooper were complete. Cooper pleaded guilty to five criminal charges, including possession of stolen property over \$5,000, wielding a prohibited firearm and criminal negligence causing bodily harm of his son who was 11 years old at the time. The 6 attempted murder charges (of RCMP officers) were dropped against him last March.

Meth-fueled shootout and police chase

Earlier this month, court heard Cooper was on a violent, meth-fueled shootout and police chase in June 2021. He was taking his 11-year old son on a road trip from Fort St. John to the Lower Mainland where he planned to sell a stolen truck and trailer, along with a modified rifle, which he used to fire at Merritt RCMP during the chase. While en route to the Lower Mainland to make the sale, Cooper detoured to Merritt to show his son where he grew up. In the shoot-out, the boy was hit by 3 non-life threatening ricocheted bullets — causing lacerations to his left & right chest wall and wrist. Cooper had a gunshot wound to his right back.

On November 7, Cooper was given a nine-year sentence, with 782 days credited for time already served.
