Heavy snow continues

Environment Canada issued a snow-fall warning last evening for Coquihalla Summit, Paulson Summit, Kootenay Pass, Rogers Pass, North and West Columbia including Blue River and Revelstoke especially to the west of Revelstoke — through early Wednesday morning.

They forecasted snowfall accumulations of 15 to 20 cm with low visibility in heavy snow. An intense frontal system is moving across the BC interior. Snow is expected to taper to light flurries or stop early Wednesday morning.

First for TNRD

For the first time the TNRD Board of Directors has elected a female chair & female vice-chair to serve during the same term. At the inaugural board meeting on November 17, the Board elected Village of Ashcroft director Barbara Roden as chair, and District of Logan Lake director Robin Smith as vice-chair.

Roden is only the second woman to serve as the TNRD Board chair (first was former City of Kamloops director Patricia Wallace, who served as Board chair 1983-1986). Roden has been the mayor of Ashcroft since 2018, and also served as a councillor between 2014 and 2018. Roden also became the first-ever female vice-chair of the TNRD Board in 2021.

Smith has been the mayor of Logan Lake since 2018, and also served as a councillor between 2014 and 2018.

Power outage planned for DeWolf Way

BC Hydro is planning power outage on Dewolf Way on Monday, Nov 28, 8am-5pm, for pole replacement. Their priority is the safety of their crews and will switch off power when necessary, so could be canceled without notice due to weather conditions or availability of crews during an emergency, and the start and end times for outages could vary.

BD Hydro suggests: Unplug electrical devices to protect them from damage. During an outage, unplug all electrical equipment and turn off items such as lights, heaters, and major appliances.

New Premier, new era?

Last Friday, David Eby was sworn in as BC's 37th Premier, in a precedent-setting ceremony held in the Musqueam Community Ctr.

The Premier promised action on the most pressing issues facing British Columbians: fixing the housing crisis, making communities safer, strengthening health care and acting on climate change.

Eby was born in 1976. [Young enough, right?] In 2004, he graduated from Schulich School of Law in Halifax, NS. He articulated for the federal Dept of Justice and was called to the bar in June 2005. He worked at Pivot Legal Society 2005-2008 in Vancouver's Downtown Eastside before becoming the exec. director of the BC Civil Liberties Assoc., 2008-2012. He was an adjunct professor of law at UBC 2009-2013, and has served as president of the Canadian HIV/AIDS Legal Network and as a research associate with the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives. [Enough education, activism & legal experience, right?]

He was first elected as MLA for Vancouver-Point Grey in 2013, serving as the Opposition critic for housing and gaming policy. After the BC NDP formed government in 2017, Eby was appointed attorney general and minister responsible for ICBC, gaming and liquor. In the 2020 BC general election, he won by a 20% margin in his Vancouver-Point Grey riding: 51% compared to 31% for the BC Liberal candidate. He was appointed as the minister responsible for housing. [Enough political experience, right?]

"His approach is calm, methodical, considerate and broad-thinking," said the former NDP cabinet minister Joy MacPhail, a mentor to Eby. [Enough hope, right?] — KL
