Nicola Mining gets more mill feed

A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between Nicola Mining & Osisko Dev. Corp for processing gold mill feed currently stockpiled southeast of Quesnel, and which originates from Barkerville Gold Mines Ltd.

The company hopes to transport approx. 15,000 tonnes of mineralized material to the Lower Nicola mill site, on the historic Craigmont Copper Mine site.

Both parties have already begun co-operative efforts and expect to enter into a Milling Profit Share Agreement soon. Concentrate from the mill feed will be sold to Ocean Partners UK Ltd, with whom the Company entered into a purchase contract last spring.

Nicola Mining's Merritt mill is the only facility in the province permitted to accept third party gold and silver mill feed from across the province.
