2023 property assessments in the mail

Owners of nearly 289,000 properties throughout the Thompson Okanagan can expect to receive their 2023 assessment notices soon, which reflect market value as of July 1, 2022.

"Homeowners throughout the Okanagan can generally expect to receive assessments that are up about 10% to 15% for houses while condos and townhomes are up a bit higher," says Okanagan area Deputy Assessor Tracy Wall. "Assessments are valued as of July 1, meaning everyone's annual assessment is a reflection of what your home could have sold for around that time."

In Merritt, a home that was assessed at \$416,000 last year, will be now be assessed at \$475,000 — an increase of 14%.

BC Assessment's website at bcassessment.ca includes more details about 2023 assessments, property info and trends, such as lists of 2023's top valued residential properties across the province.

The website also provides self-service access to a free, online property assessment search service that allows anyone to search, check and compare 2023 property assessments for anywhere in the province. There are also additional property search features by registering for a free BC Assessment custom account.

Those who feel that their property assessment does not reflect market value as of July 1, 2022 or see incorrect information on their notice, should contact BC Assessment as indicated on their notice as soon as possible. After speaking to an appraiser, they may submit a Notice of Complaint (Appeal) by January 31st, for an independent review by a Property Assessment Review Panel, which meets Feb 1-March 15 to hear formal complaints.

Province pauses on power to crypto- currency mining

BC Hydro will suspend electricity-connection requests from cryptocurrency mining operations for 18 months, while they engage with industry and First Nations, to develop a permanent framework for any future cryptocurrency mining operations, such as Bitcoin.

"We are suspending electricity connection requests from cryptocurrency mining operators to preserve our electricity supply for people who are switching to electric vehicles and heat pumps, and for businesses and industries that are undertaking electrification projects that reduce carbon emissions and generate jobs and economic opportunities," said Josie Osborne, Minister of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation.

BC's clean, affordable electricity has attracted unprecedented interest from cryptocurrency miners. Currently, 21 projects are requesting a total of 1,403 megawatts that will be temporarily suspended. That is equivalent to the energy needed to power approximately 570,000 homes, or 2.1 million electric vehicles, per year in BC.

In fact, the 21 cryptocurrency mining businesses would completely wipe out the new electrical capacity gained by building the \$16 billion Site C hydroelectric dam, which has an output capacity of 1,100 megawatts or enough power for the equivalent of 450,000 homes. Site C is expected to be operational by 2025.

Cryptocurrency mining, such as Bitcoin, use a very substantial amount of electricity to operate high-powered computers around the clock, which perform complex cryptographic and math problems to verify transactions. High electricity needs are the result of not only to run the racks of computers, but to provide extreme cooling given the significant heat produced.
