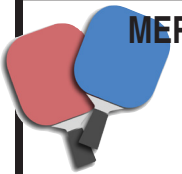

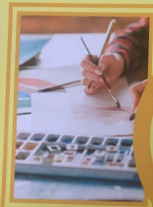

The Lunar New Year started yesterday, Jan 22, and will last until Feb 1. Though celebrations last up to 16 days, only the first 7 days are considered a public holiday. The celebration will reach its peak with the Lantern Festival on Feb 5.

New technology for Hwy 5A

New technology that monitors commercial vehicles on Hwy 5A will be implemented approx. 3km north of Merritt, that will monitor commercial vehicles at highway speeds using sensors built into and above the highway.

Weigh-in-motion and automatic vehicle-identification systems will measure real-time safety & vehicle data, such as weight, height & tire conditions, and compare the data against enforced standards.

Commercial vehicle data will be relayed directly to mobile Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement officers in the area, enabling more efficient intervention and enforcement of safety standards. This new system will be the first exclusively virtual system in the province.

Highway 5A is an important alternative route for the trucking industry as the higher elevations make the Coquihalla Highway more susceptible to extreme weather conditions. Commercial vehicles also use Highway 5A for local deliveries, forestry and agriculture. However, truck speed & severe accidents have worried residents along the route, and several calls for banning truck traffic have been made over the years.

Construction is expected to begin in late spring and be completed in the fall.
