TNRD supports Nicola-Coldwater flood mapping

The TNRD Board of directors voted to support TNRD staff participation and engagement with the Fraser Basin Council and BGC Engineering on the Nicola-Coldwater Floodplain Mapping project. The project was initially presented by the Fraser Basin Council to the TNRD Board on December 15.

The project consists of updating floodplain maps, an important tool to help local governments fulfill their responsibilities for land use planning and floodplain management, under the Local Government Act, as well as emergency preparedness and response under the Emergency Program Act. Good information about potential flood depth and extent can inform different kinds of planning and decision making such as: Informing land use planning policies and development decisions; Assessing potential impacts to people and other community values and assets; Preparing or updating emergency response plans; and Informing other flood mitigation and climate adaptation measures.

Depending on the bylaws developed by the TNRD, in areas where new flood risks are identified from new floodplain maps, this could impact where, if, and how landowners can develop land in the future.

Avalanche risk

The Province is urging people to be prepared and extremely cautious in the backcountry, with continued *high* and *considerable* avalanche risk forecast in many areas of BC.

Avalanche Canada continues to forecast dangerous snowpack and urges everyone to exercise heightened levels of caution and vigilance in the backcountry this season. This year's snowpack is being compared to 2003, which was one of the worst years for avalanche fatalities.

They are monitoring a "deep, persistent slab avalanche problem for many regions. This is causing very dangerous and highly unpredictable avalanche conditions. Avalanche Canada continues to encourage people to stay away from steep slopes and terrain, and to check: www.avalanche.ca for avalanche conditions for forecasts."

"Being caught in an avalanche is a life-threatening situation that has already claimed 5 lives in British Columbia this year," said Bowinn Ma, Minister of Emergency Management & Climate Readiness.

During the past 10 years, approximately 73% of all Canadian avalanche fatalities have occurred in BC. Approximately 85% of Avalanche Canada's services are delivered in this province.

The Scottish Bard Robbie Burns Day

Robert Burns was born 25 January, 1759 in Alloway, Scotland. He found major success at 27 with poems such as *To a Louse*, *To a Mouse*, and *The Cotter's Saturday Night*. His poetry focused on aspects of farm life, regional experience, traditional culture, class culture, and religious practice. He died in 1796 at 37 years old.

Burn's Night was first held in 1801 by his close friends. An evening supper was held in honour of his life. Today, it is common to enjoy the traditional Scottish dish consisting of haggis (a savoury pudding containing meat, onion, and spices) and scotch whisky. Along with the meal, many people will recite Robert Burns' poetry.

According to Scotland.org, with the exception of Queen Victoria and Christopher Columbus, there are more statues dedicated to Robert Burns than any other non-religious figure.

The largest collection of Robert Burns' work is said to be in Glasgow's Mitchell Library. His work there has been translated into almost 30 different languages.
