

City looking for new dog shelter services

The City of Merritt is seeking Expressions of Interest to provide Dog Shelter Services. Historically, dogs that have been brought in by City Bylaw or RCMP have been sheltered temporarily at the City's Public Works yard. These days, they are held for a few days, before being transported to Princeton.

With planned flood recovery infrastructure improvements, including a dike, the City is looking at demolishing the current shelter and is exploring options for a new service and / or location to provide temporary shelter for dogs.

The City welcomes private organizations, non-profits, and societies to replace the current shelter within the vicinity of the City of Merritt. 
