Late winter storm misses Merritt

While significant snow fell throughout the province Saturday & Sunday, the storm — except for some winds & a dusting of snow — for the most part, missed the Nicola Valley.

Travel advisory & storm warnings were in place for many BC highways & mountain passes. The biggest evidence of what was going on throughout the province was the many cars caked with hardpacked snow coming off the highways.

Overnight Saturday, in the Interior, Sicamous received 30-40cm snow, Salmon Arm airport 17cm, the Coquihalla Summit 14cm & Kamloops airport 12cm. The hardest hit area was Malakwa (in Shuswap Country) with 55cm.

Other hard-hit areas include Squamish area 40-49cm, Chilliwack area & Harrison Hot Springs 30cm, Surrey area 20-30cm, Port Coquitlam & Burnaby 25-33cm, and Vancouver area 15-21cm.

The snowfall warning continued through last evening for Revelstoke, Malakwa, Shuswap and the Trans-Canada Highway through Eagle Pass and Rogers Pass.
