Still more snow

Environment Canada's forecast is for the heavy snow to continue through to this afternoon on the Coquihalla Highway, Hope to Merritt. They are forecasting total snow accumulations of 20-30 cm.

They advise of "difficult driving conditions due to slippery surfaces and reduced visibility in heavy snow."

"In the wake of an outgoing frontal system, moist southwest flows will continue to give snow to Coquihalla Highway - Hope to Merritt. Heavy snow tonight will gradually taper off to flurries Friday afternoon."

City signs agreement with TNRD for fire services in areas M&N

During the February 14th Council meeting, Mayor & Council voted unanimously to sign a 1-year agreement with TNRD for structural fire protection services for 482 addresses in areas M (Beautiful Nicola Valley North) & N (Beautiful Nicola Valley South) — east to Harmon Estate Rd. on Nicola Lake & west to Miller Estates Rd. Excluded from the agreement are Sunshine Valley & Canford properties, and those along Spius Creek.

The new annual fee for the agreement is \$270,000. This is up from \$154,000 in 2022, and comes after a review by TNRD for the whole regional district last year which showed that the City of Merritt was being underfunded compared to other jurisdictions.

"As we move this year, we are committed to negotiating further with the regional district with respect to the terms and the dollar value of future fire suppression agreements," said Fire Chief Dave Tomkinson.

The new agreement updates language and indemnification, protects the City, and ensures the fire department does not breach their responsibility to the citizens of Merritt or its Insurers. The new pricing model more equally shares the cost of operating the Merritt Fire Rescue Department while benefitting TNRD residents.

Though Chief Tomkinson says there is still further work to be done to negotiate an appropriate rate for a multi-year agreement — for 2024 and beyond — this year's new rate is much more fair and represents a significant increase in funding versus prior years.

Forest fires suppression and response to medical incidents are not included in the agreement. Historically response to fire emergencies in the proposed area is low, less than 15 per year.

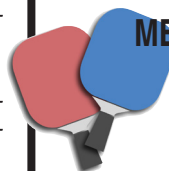
