Please recycle

Curbside recycling, not 'wish-cycling'

The City of Merritt warns that when unacceptable items are placed in the curbside recycling bins, they cause the whole lot to be contaminated, and the entire load needs to be dealt with as garbage.

Equipment is used to manage the recycling process — there is not enough manpower to sort the genuine recycling from the “wish-cycling.”

What CANNOT go in city curbside bins: NO glass, NO plastic bags or other thing flexible plastics, NO paper towels or tissues, NO foam including meat trays, NO books, NO batteries, propane tanks, or other hazardous waste, including bleach, motor oil, and paint containers. Nothing with a Danger or Poison symbol. NO lightbulbs, NO electronics or appliances. NO pots, pans, hangers, or scrap metal. NO waste. No compost. No containers. ALL MATERIAL MUST BE CLEAN.

However, the above materials may be taken to the Lower Nicola Eco-Depot to be recycled.

Covid updates — on 3rd anniv. of declaration of pandemic

On March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 viral disease a pandemic. Things have now relaxed, as we pass the 3-year mark...

Mandatory vaccination rescinded for provincial public servants

As of April 3, 2023, BC Public Service employees will no longer be required to provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19. The decision to rescind the policy was made based on the high level of vaccination among public-service employees and the current state of the pandemic. More than 98% of employees met the requirement, which helped keep everyone safe.

Rescinding the vaccination policy means a small number of employees on administrative leave due to non-compliance will be provided the opportunity to return to the workplace. The Public Service Agency has provided direction to ministries and will work with supervisors to support a smooth transition. This change also means that contractors and other non-employees do not need to be vaccinated to enter BC Public Service workplaces.

Spring COVID-19 boosters

On Friday, Dr. Bonnie Henry, B.C.'s provincial health officer, and Adrian Dix, Minister of Health, have issued the following statement:

“As we enter spring and the third year of the COVID-19 pandemic, it is crucial that we continue to remain vigilant in our efforts to protect ourselves, our loved ones and our communities from COVID-19. This includes staying up to date on our immunizations, which are an essential tool in combating the spread of the virus.

“The National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI) recently issued guidance on additional booster doses of COVID-19 vaccine. B.C. will be adopting this guidance; people at high risk of severe illness including individuals older than 80, all seniors in long-term care homes, Indigenous people older than 70 and people 18 and older who are moderately to severely immunocompromised can get a spring booster.

“In addition to high-risk individuals, people 60 and older, or Indigenous people 50 and older, who have not previously contracted COVID-19, can also consider receiving a spring booster dose.”
