Spring debris burning creates harmful air pollution

This is a letter to TNRD Director David Laird. Also, this letter was forwarded to the Minister of Environment, BC Lung Foundation, Mayor Goetz and Chief Stuart Jackson.

"Hello David, is there nothing you can do about the Wild West of debris burning in our High Smoke Sensitivity Zone valley in Lower Nicola? It has been hell here lately with huge debris burns going on for the last month. Some are only less than a mile from the school, and today's [Mar 8] burn is about one mile from Shulus elementary. Both Nicola Canford & Shulus Elementary school are always covered in smoke. This is totally unacceptable according to B.C. Lung Foundation and the Provincial Open Burning Regulations. I am sending picture of this week's fires and will be sending this letter to Minister George Heyman & Mayor Mike Goetz. I will be awaiting your reply.
