Categories 2 & 3 fire prohibitions

Effective at 12 noon tomorrow Thursday, May 18, Cat. 2 and Cat. 3 open fires, as well as other equipment and activities will be prohibited throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre. This prohibition is being enacted to help prevent human-caused wildfires and protect public safety. It will remain in effect until 12 noon on Oct. 13, or until the order is rescinded.

The prohibition includes burning pile, stubble or grass, fireworks, sky lanterns, binary exploding targets, burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description, and air curtain burners. These prohibitions apply to all public and private land within the Kamloops Fire Centre jurisdiction.

This prohibition does not include campfires 0.5m high x 0.5m wide or smaller, and does not apply to cooking stoves that use gas, propane, or briquettes. FMI www.bcwildfire.ca

Backcountry access restored after 2021 wildfire closures

Several backcountry roads that were closed to motor vehicles for environmental protection after the 2021 wildfires have reopened.

After a review of fire severity, degree of recovery and restoration activities in the affected areas, the Province has determined the closures can be reduced and, in some cases, removed.

Seven road closures have been rescinded, all within the Thompson-Okanagan region: Nk'Mip, Momich Lake, Two Mile Road, Bunting Road, Hunakwa Lake/ Crazy Creek Gorge, Mowhokam Creek and Garrison Lake

Six of the remaining closed areas are being modified to improve public access while continuing to protect the environment: Sparks Lake, Tremont Creek Thomas Creek, Lytton Creek/George Road, July Mountain and McKay Creek. Motor vehicles will be permitted within these areas, provided they stay on existing roads and trails. Off-road vehicle use in these areas is still prohibited.

School District 58 will be part of an expansion of the 2019 Seamless Day Kindergarten pilot program — though the host school still has not been determined.

Seamless Day Kindergarten integrates before- and after-school care into the kindergarten classroom, delivered by certified early childhood educators (ECEs) who work alongside the classroom teacher. The program makes the best use of available school space, existing classrooms, outdoors, school gyms and libraries outside of school hours.

The Province provided \$3 million in 2022-23 to add 20 classrooms, including Nicola-Similkameen SD58, expanding the Seamless Day Kindergarten to 45 classrooms throughout the province. In 2023-24, \$4.1 million in new funding will be provided to support the Seamless Day Kindergarten pilot.


