## New cancer centre at RIH years after it was promised

Yesterday, Minister of Health Adrian Dix announced the approval of the concept plan for the new cancer care centre in Kamloops at Royal Inland Hospital.

Concept planning is a key part of the capital management and funding process that takes into account the need for investment, including identifying specific needs and how a project can support service-delivery requirements.

Business planning for the new cancer-care centre is now underway to determine the project scope, schedule and budget. Plans are also underway to build a 470-stall parkade, as well as upgrades to the existing community oncology clinic, and renovation & expansion of the existing pharmacy.

The new centre is expected to provide radiation treatment to 1,000 patients in its opening year, which will result in 14,000 treatment visits per year.

The centre was promised as part of the 2020 election by former premier John Horgan, previously promised by the NDP government in the 1990s.

The new cancer centre is a part of the 10-year B.C. Cancer Action Plan, and is expected to be ready for patients in 2027.

## Motorcyclist stopped for excessive speed & flight from police

On May 14, at approx. 7pm, an officer with BC Highway Patrol – Merritt was conducting speed enforcement on Hwy 5 at the Juliet Bridge, when he observed a motorcycle traveling fast in the north-bound lanes.

He established that the motorcycle was traveling 199 km/h in a posted 100 km/h zone, and it matched the description of a speeding motorcycle that had failed to stop for police on May 12. The motorcycle failed to stop yet again — however in the interest of public safety, the officer did not pursue.

He radioed ahead to his colleagues who took up position in the area. A final speed of 209 km/h was established before the motorcycle exited the highway, ending up at the intersection of Vogt St where an officer had taken up position.

The driver of the motorcycle performed a u-turn in a failed attempt to get away, however he wiped out and was quickly taken into custody.

Motorcycle safety can not be over-stated, according to BC Highway Patrol. You aren't inside the metal frame of a larger vehicle that could protect you in the event of a collision. Riding a motorcycle in this manner shows a complete disregard for the safety of the public.

The motorcycle was impounded and confirmed to be the same one that had previously fled from police. The rider and owner, an 18 year-old Chilliwack man with a Novice motorcycle licence, was also determined to be carrying a separate fictitious driver's licence. He now faces multiple charges and was released from custody to appear in Court next month.
