No watering restrictions, but City urges conservation

With the high river levels (ie, high water table) & no update yet on the BC Drought Information Portal, the City has not yet issued any watering restrictions.

In the meantime, they ask residents to continue to practice good water conservation habits — since the City expects another long, dry hot summer, and will institute restrictions (as in past years) as the need arises.

Typically, residents use 2.5 times the amount of water than the winter months, mostly due to lawn watering. FMI www.merritt.ca/mindful-water-use

Funding for LNIB's Emerg. Ops Centre

The Lower Nicola Indian Band is one of the more than 100 local governments and First Nations to benefit from provincial funding to support and enhance the work of local emergency operations centres. For LNIB's EOC program, the total approved funding is \$30,000.

Nearly \$3 million through the Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) will go to local governments and First Nations throughout B.C. and will assist in purchasing and installing equipment and supplies to maintain or improve emergency operations centres as well as training and exercises to increase capacity.
