Property taxes due July 4th

The deadline for property taxes is fast approaching. All payments are due by July 4, by 5:45pm.

First, claim the BC Home Owners Grant through the Province of BC — either online at www.gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant or by phone 1-888-355-2700.

Then, you can pay via your online banking, by mail with a cheque, or cash or debit in person (credit cards not accepted). Allow 3 business days to a week to ensure receipt of mailed cheques or online banking prior to the July 4 deadline. Postmarks are not accepted. There is a 10% late payment penalty on unpaid accounts. This penalty also applies to any unclaimed grant amounts.

City Hall is open Tues-Fri 8am-5:45pm, except lunch 12noon-1:15pm.

CBC News

Climate dashboard

CBC.ca has published a new project which pulls together current & historical weather data for about 500 locations in Canada — the CBC News Climate Dashboard.

At the top of the dashboard, an interactive globe shows the temperature records for the day across Canada. The content below will give you more information on a specific location: current conditions as well as hourly and daily forecasts.

It also shows historical trends. How many days were above 0°C last winter? Are the number of days above 30°C above average this spring? Were the previous 30 days extremely hot compared to the historical average?

And finally you can explore the latest temperature projections up to the year 2100, with different scenarios. For now, the Climate Dashboard focuses on temperatures, but they promise to add more variables, like precipitation, in the coming months.

In Merritt, the dashboard shows record highs on June 20: 1970 temperature high was 34.4°C, 2004 34°C, 1982 33°C

Record lows for yesterday: 1966 temperature low was 0°C, 1964 2.8°C, 1933 3.9°C

It also tells us that this spring has seen 10 days above 30°C so far — that's 8 days above the historic average of 2 days.

And it projects that if we keep developing a fossil fuel-based economy (high-emission scenario), the average annual temperature will increase by 4.1°C to 7.7°C in Merritt by the end of the century, compared to the average from 1981-2010. If we maintain current development patterns (medium-emission scenario), the temperature will rise by 2.4°C to 4.9°C. If governments make a major shift now toward sustainable development (low-emission scenario), the increase will be between 1.4°C to 3.6°C.
