Coun. Claire Newman dies in hit & run

RCMP have confirmed that a 46-year-old Claire Newman was killed along Hwy 16 near Valemount, shortly after midnight on Wednesday. She had been travelling to pick up a family member.

Police said they found her, in a ditch near a Nissan Frontier. The vehicle was running and unlocked, and there was a dog inside the vehicle. Police say evidence at the scene suggested that Claire may have been outside her car and was struck by a vehicle. They also say they located a headlight assembly nearby that they have identified as coming from a grey 2016 to 2018 Jeep Cherokee.

The City of Merritt, municipality of Logan Lake & the TNRD building are lowering their flags to half-mast in mourning of Claire's passing.

A memorial is available in Merritt Council Chamber in City Hall. Flowers, cards, mementos are being collected for her family. Come in and sign the memory book, write a story or paste in a photo.

The City will be cancelling its regular council meeting for July 11, and will dedicate this time to a quiet gathering, open to the public, to honour Claire's passing.
